

Bills Committee on Electronic Health Record Sharing System Bill

**List of follow-up actions arising from the discussion
at the meeting on 14 October 2014**

The Administration was requested to -

- (a) provide the Terms of Reference and membership list of the Steering Committee on Electronic Health Record Sharing and advise whether it intended to retain or change the advisory structure upon the commencement of operation of the Electronic Health Record Sharing System ("eHRSS");
- (b) advise how the scope of data for electronic health record sharing ("the sharable scope") in Stage 1 eHRSS was determined and the extent of information to be included for sharing under each type of data, and advise whether and how the sharable scope and/or the extent of information which had been included for sharing in Stage 1 eHRSS would be expanded in future;
- (c) advise how it would further collaborate with the private information technology vendors on the future development of Stage 2 eHRSS, in particular whether it would contract out some of the information technology development work such as the development of clinical software or systems for eHRSS connection;
- (d) advise whether the service location(s) for which a healthcare provider had registered for eHRSS is(are) the location(s) where the provider could access eHRSS; and
- (e) provide a written response to the letter dated 28 July 2014 from Dr Hon Elizabeth QUAT (LC Paper No. CB(2)2149/13-14(01)) concerning the Administration's response to her letter dated 11 July 2014 as set out in LC Paper No. CB(2)2130/13-14(01).
