

**Bills Committee on Electronic Health Record Sharing System Bill**

**List of follow-up actions arising from the discussion  
at the meeting on 11 November 2014**

The Administration was requested to -

- (a) re-affirm the latest direction of the study on provision of additional means for healthcare recipients to restrict access to their sharable data under the Electronic Health Record Sharing System ("eHRSS") which was targeted to commence in the first year of Stage Two of the Electronic Health Record Programme;
- (b) clarify whether clauses 12(6)(a)(i) and (b)(i) as presently drafted would render it not viable for registered healthcare recipients to request prescribed healthcare providers and referral healthcare providers, to which they had given a sharing consent, not to provide to eHRSS certain parts of their health data within the sharable scope; and
- (c) provide a comparison table on the new offences proposed under the Bill and relevant offences as currently provided for under existing laws and setting out whether there was any overlapping in the scope of coverage of the offences.
