

**Bills Committee on Electronic Health Record Sharing System Bill**

**List of follow-up actions arising from the discussion  
at the meeting on 24 June 2014**

1. The Administration was requested to -
  - (a) advise the security and privacy safeguards that had incorporated into the system design and/or operation flow under the Public Private Interface-Electronic Patient Record Sharing Pilot Project, such as the principle(s) governing the access by specified personnel of a private healthcare provider to the patients' electronic health record in the Hospital Authority; and
  - (b) provide a response in respect of the concerns raised by the Privacy Commissioner for Personal Data at the meeting on privacy protection in the future Electronic Health Record Sharing System, including, inter alia, those related to the response provided by the Administration in LC Paper No. CB(2)1775/13-14(02).
  
2. The Office of the Privacy Commissioner for Personal Data was invited to comment on the adequacy of the safeguards for protection of privacy under the Public Private Interface-Electronic Patient Record Sharing Pilot Project upon receipt of the information to be provided by the Administration under paragraph 1(a).
