Speech by the Secretary for Transport and Housing in Moving a Motion to Amend the Road Traffic (Construction and Maintenance of Vehicles) (Amendment)
Regulation 2014 at the Meeting of the Legislative Council on 19 March 2014

President,

I move that the motion as set out on the Agenda regarding an amendment to the Road Traffic (Construction and Maintenance of Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulation 2014 ("the Amendment Regulation") be passed.

The Amendment Regulation was published in the Gazette on 17 January 2014 to require goods vehicles first registered on or after 1 October 2014 to be equipped with reversing video devices, with a view to enhancing safety when goods vehicles are reversing.

I would like to express my gratitude for the scrutiny of the Amendment Regulation done and valuable advice tendered by the Subcommittee chaired by the Hon CHAN Kam-lam. I am glad to learn that the Subcommittee supported the Amendment Regulation after deliberations. At the Subcommittee meeting, a member asked if it would be more appropriate to replace "揭發" with "發現" or "發覺" in the Chinese rendition of the Amendment Regulation for the word "detected" in regulation 39A(6) under section 4 in the English text. The Department of Justice accepted the suggestion of the Subcommittee after consideration. The amendment I propose today mainly serves to improve the drafting of the Chinese text by repealing "揭發" and substituting it with "發覺" in the proposed regulation 39A(6)(a) and (b) under section 4 of the Amendment Regulation.

President, with these remarks, I move that the motion as set out under my name on the Agenda regarding the amendment to the Road Traffic (Construction and Maintenance of Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulation 2014 be passed.
