## Report No. 7/13-14 of the House Committee on Consideration of Subsidiary Legislation and Other Instruments

## **Purpose**

This report gives the outcome of the consideration of the House Committee on subsidiary legislation the period for amendment of which will expire at the Council meeting of 18 December 2013.

## Subsidiary legislation considered

2. The House Committee has considered the following items of subsidiary legislation -

3. The House Committee formed two subcommittees to study items (1) and (2) respectively in detail at its meetings on 1 and 22 November 2013. The two Subcommittees made verbal reports at the House Committee meeting on

- 6 December 2013, and provided their written reports vide LC Paper Nos. CB(1)508/13-14 and CB(4)224/13-14 issued to Members respectively on 11 and 10 December 2013.
- 4. In respect of items (3) and (4), the House Committee considered it not necessary to form any subcommittee to study these items of subsidiary legislation.
- Note: The House Committee formed a subcommittee to study the Waste Disposal (Designated Waste Disposal Facility) (Amendment) Regulation 2013 (L.N. 188/2013) and the Waste Disposal (Refuse Transfer Station) (Amendment) Regulation 2013 (L.N. 189/2013) at its meeting on 6 December 2013. The Council passed on 11 December 2013 a resolution moved by Hon Andrew LEUNG, Chairman of the House Committee, to extend the period for amending the two Regulations to the Council meeting of 22 January 2014.

The House Committee also formed two subcommittees to study the following three items of subsidiary legislation at its meetings on 22 and 29 November 2013 respectively. The Chairmen of the two relevant Subcommittees have given notices respectively to move proposed resolutions at the Council meeting of 18 December 2013 to extend the scrutiny period of these 3 items of subsidiary legislation. Details are as follows –
