Hearing of the Second Report of HKSAR under the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child	18 November 2013	The Administration undertook to provide supplementary information on the existing arrangements in the provision of the Learning Support Grant for mainstream schools (i.e., a grant of \$10,000 or \$20,000 per Special education Needs ("SEN") student per annum depending on the degree of support needed) to address to calls by some parents of SEN students that such grant should be provided to the SEN student on an reimbursement basis instead, to enable them to arrange speech training and to meet the maintenance cost of the cochlear implant devices.	The Education Bureau provided an information paper on 6 February 2014 [LC Paper No. CB(2)810/13-14(01)].

Issues relating to the duty reports of the Chief Executive	20 January 2014	The Administration was requested to convey the concerns raised by members on this subject matter to the Chief Executive's Office ("CEO") and seek the provision of a written response from CEO.
