Revision of Fees under Builders' Lifts and Tower Working Platforms (Safety) (Fees) Regulation (Cap 470A)

under the purview of the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department

PURPOSE

This paper outlines the Administration's proposed revision of eight Government fees for services related to builders' lifts and tower working platforms under the purview of the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department (EMSD) which do not directly affect people's livelihood or general business activities.

THE PROPOSAL

- 2. In line with the "user-pays" principle, it is Government's policy that fees charged by the Government should in general be set at levels sufficient to recover the full cost of providing the services. The eight fee items concerned are prescribed in the Schedule of the Builders' Lifts and Tower Working Platforms (Safety) (Fees) Regulation (Cap 470A) and were last revised in February 2001.
- 3. A review of the cost of providing the relevant services at the 2014-15 price level has been carried out recently. The result shows the cost recovery rates at existing fee levels range from 78.1% to 83.3%. In order to achieve full cost recovery gradually and avoid a steep fee increase, we propose to adopt an increase of about 10% for the fee revision.
- 4. Details of the fee revision proposal with upward adjustments ranging from 9.7% to 10.6% are at **Annex**. After the proposed revision is implemented, the cost recovery rates will range from 85.8% to 92.1%. We will revise the fees once the legislative amendment procedures are completed.

EFFICIENCY IMPROVEMENT MEASURES

5. The Administration will continue to enhance efficiency and streamline procedures so as to contain the costs of providing these public services.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATION

6. When the proposed fee adjustments are implemented, the estimated increase in revenue is about \$22,500 per annum.

WAY FORWARD

7. Members are invited to note the proposed fee revision as set out in paragraphs 3 to 4 above and detailed in the **Annex**. We will proceed with the necessary legislative amendments to implement the adjustments.
