## Follow-up Action Arising from the Meeting on 24 March 2014 - Response from the Administration

## <u>Item 1 Matters on Hong Kong's municipal solid waste recovery rate</u> and handling of imported waste

The Administration to consider adding a new classification category of "waste plastics" in Hong Kong's import and export trade statistics.

A comprehensive multi-purpose classification is already in place for use by customs and statistical authorities, traders, carriers and others concerned with international trade. There are six codes covering different types of waste plastics, and these codes are tabulated with some examples given in **Annex 1** for reference. There is therefore no need to add another classification category of "waste plastics" in Hong Kong's import and export trade statistics.
