Supplementary Information

In considering LC Paper No. CB(1)1292/13-14(05) at the meeting of 28 April 2014, the Panel on Environmental Affairs (EA Panel) requested us to provide information on whether and how the Food and Health Bureau's proposed temporary holding facilities in the vicinity of Fu Tei Au Tsuen next to Man Kam To Road for imported live poultry would impact on the design and treatment capacity of Shek Wu Hui Sewage Treatment Works (SWHSTW).

We provide the following information for Members' reference.

Having evaluated various options in response to the suggestion on the separate holding of imported and local live poultry before avian influenza (AI) testing results are ready, the Government is now focusing on the setting up of a checkpoint for local live chickens (the facility) in Ta Kwu Ling that will facilitate the continued supply of local live chickens in the event of the detection of AI virus in imported poultry that leads to the closure of the wholesale poultry market. It is expected that the facility will generate about 100 cubic metres (m³) of wastewater per day which are planned to be treated in the SWHSTW. Such volume of additional wastewater would not affect the proposed advance works of the Phase 1A expansion of the SWHSTW, the treatment capacity of which will increase from 93 000 to 105 000 m³ per day.
