LegCo Panel on Food Safety and Environmental Hygiene Powdered Formula Supply Chain

When the LegCo Panel on Food Safety and Environmental Hygiene discussed the captioned subject at its meeting of 10 June 2014, Members requested for supplementary information from the Administration. Our reply is as follows:

(a) Enforcement actions taken by the Customs and Excise Department (C&ED) against the export of powdered formula without an export licence or an exemption since the commencement of the Import and Export (General) (Amendment) Regulation 2013 on 1 March 2013, including (i) the total number of cases; (ii) the quantity of powdered formula involved in each case; and (iii) a breakdown of the enforcement actions taken against these cases.

As at the end of May 2014, the C&ED detected a total of 6 256 cases in contravention of the relevant provisions and seized 141 677 kg of powdered formula. The quantities of powdered formula involved in individual cases varied significantly, ranging from the smallest of 0.75 kg to the largest of 29 672 kg. Of

these cases, 20 (involving 75 979 kg of powdered formula) were related to smuggling of a large amount of powdered formula or warehouses of powdered formula, while the remaining 6 236 cases (involving 65 698 kg of powdered formula) were detected at various boundary control points.

(b) Implementation of the Coupon Scheme, including (i) the number of local parents using the Scheme; (ii) the monthly quantity of powdered formula purchased via the Scheme since its implementation; and (iii) the number of participating pharmacies (please provide a breakdown by the 18 districts).

According to the figures provided to us by the seven major suppliers¹, since the seven major suppliers and the Hong Kong General Chamber of Pharmacy Limited (HKGCPL) announced in June 2013 the implementation of the Coupon Scheme, a total of 3 118 requests for coupons were made by local parents of infants and young children up to the end of June 2014. The table below shows the monthly quantity of powdered formula sold via the Coupon Scheme.

¹ The seven major suppliers include Abbott, Cow & Gate, Friso, Mead Johnson, Nestle, Snow Brand and Wyeth. They account for over 95% of the market share.

(c) Implementation of pre-order service hotlines of powdered formula provided by the suppliers, including (i) the number of local parents using the hotlines; and (ii) the monthly number of orders placed and total quantity of powdered formula purchased through the hotlines since their implementation.

According to the figures provided to us by the seven major suppliers, since the announcement of the implementation of the Coupon Scheme in June 2013 up to the end of June 2014, the monthly number of users of the pre-order services for home delivery or collection from retail outlets, as well as the quantity of powdered formula sold through the services are shown in the table below:
