**Panel on Security
Follow-up to meeting on 3 June 2014**

At the Panel on Security meeting on 3 June 2014, Members requested supplementary information on Agenda Item IV "Police's efforts in engaging the district community in crime prevention". Our reply is as follows:

Audience Rating of "Police Magazine"

"Police Magazine" is broadcast every Saturday evening on TVB Jade Channel. According to the statistics of the Radio Television Hong Kong, the programme's audience rating was approximately 8.7 to 10.8 in May 2014, corresponding to 566 000 to 702 000 viewers.

School Visits by School Liaison Officers

In a bid to promote anti-crime messages, the Police maintain close liaison with schools, school social workers, students and parents through School Liaison Officers (SLOs) as a joint effort to combat and prevent juvenile delinquency. In 2013, the SLOs paid more than 19 000 visits to schools, i.e. each SLO conducted 196 visits on average. By means of meetings with school representatives, students or parents, individual discussions, talks, interviews with students and so forth during such visits, the Police wish to instil a sense of discipline and correct values in students and provide assistance to schools in the prevention of students' involvement in crime and juvenile delinquency.
