LegCo Panel on Security visits Stanley Prison (with photos)

At the invitation of the Administration, the Legislative Council ("LegCo") Panel on Security conducted a site visit to Stanley Prison today (November 25) to better understand the operations of the Prison. In addition to the seven members (including the Chairman) of the Panel on Security, two other non-Panel Members also joined the visit.

Accompanied by the Commissioner of Correctional Services Department, Mr SIN Yat-kin, nine LegCo Members visited Stanley Prison. Members first received a briefing on the Correctional Services Department and Stanley Prison. They then toured the control room, cells, graphic media workshop, CDI exhibition gallery, printing and shoe-making workshop as well as computer study room. They were briefed by the Administration on the work and training provided for persons in custody. Members also visited the hospital and kitchen to understand the medical and meal arrangements for persons in custody. Before leaving, Members toured a historical cell to learn more about the development of the cell.

Speaking after the visit, the Chairman of the LegCo Panel on Security, Hon IP Kwok-him, said that the visit enabled Members to better understand the operations of the Correctional Services Department and Stanley Prison, including the facilities and meal arrangements for persons in custody, and this would facilitate the Panel's discussion on the related issues in the future.
