The Legislative Council ("LegCo") Panel on Food Safety and Environmental Hygiene conducted a site visit to the Man Kam To Food Control Office today (February 24) to better understand the operation of food surveillance and tests on imported vegetables from the Mainland by the Centre for Food Safety ("CFS") at Man Kam To Control Point.

Members received briefing on the work as well as facilities of the Man Kam To Food Control Office and Man Kam To Food Laboratory by CFS officers. They then observed the checks on imported vegetables demonstrated by the officers.

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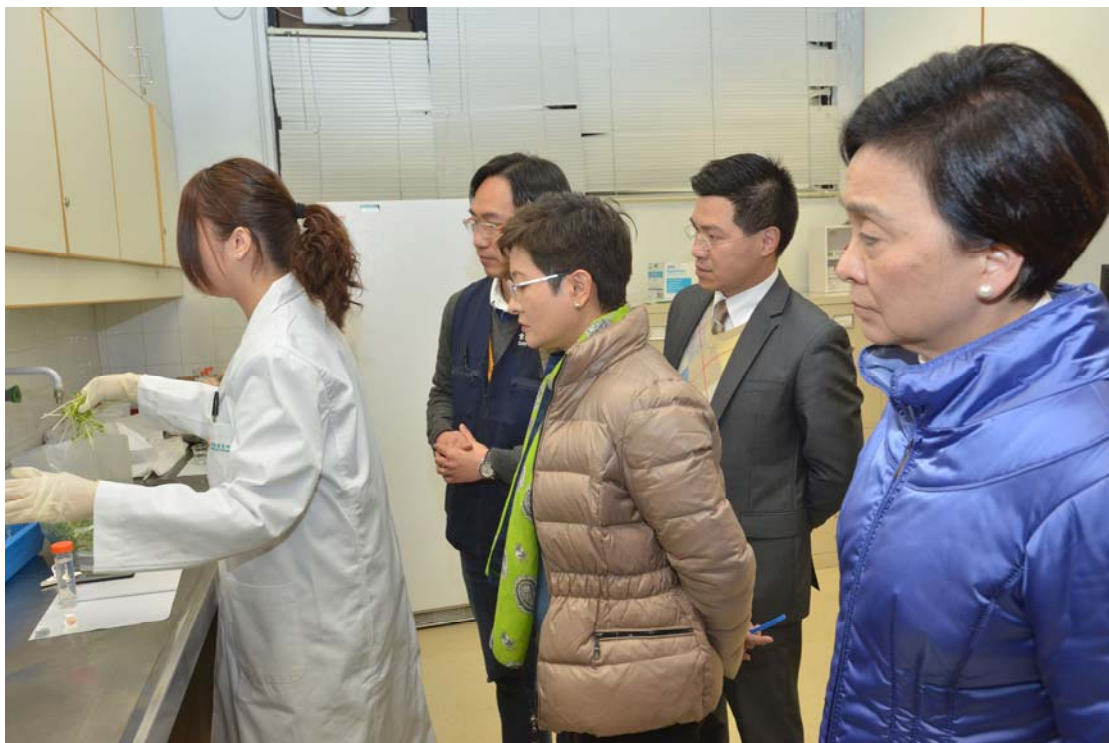
