**要求召開公聽會討論
大學資助委員會的政策對專上教育發展的影響**

本人接獲理工大學教職員協會的來函(見附件)，提及近年大學資助委員會(下稱學資會)的政策嚴重影響到資助院校的發展。學資會運用新的撥款模式，按照研究評審工作、優配研究金的計算金額，與及優配學位政策，從而決定資助院校的撥款額度和學額分配。該會認為該等新政策所引發的不良效果，導致資助院校的不良發展。除該組織外，浸會大學教職員工會代表及香港教育專業人員協會會長亦向本人表達同類關注，要求本委員會召開公聽會，以表達有關議題的意見。

鑒於學資會每三年度對各資助院校的撥款將於本年九月作出決定。就此，本人特致函閣下，促請閣下考慮本人和附函團體的建議，盡快安排於九月前召開公聽會，並邀請本港專上教育持份者團體代表和關心該議題的團體和人士出席，以向政府當局和學資會表達其意見和憂慮。

On behalf of the Hong Kong Polytechnic University Staff Association (hereafter PUSA), which is also the sole body to represent staff members of the University, I am writing to you, of whom your Honorable self is also a member of the Legislative Council Education Panel, to plead for your assistance to arrange a Public Hearing Session on the trends and problems of the development of Higher Education in Hong Kong resulting from the policies adopted by the University Grant Councils in recent years. We are fully aware of, and worried about, that the side effects of the "top-slicing exercise" as well as the new model of UGC funding formula based on revised RAE and GRF result calculation, are all working together in driving the directions and development of the tertiary education of Hong Kong to an unhealthy track.

We are quite sure that this is not only the concern as derived from PUSA, but a common alarm of many sister bodies at different tertiary education sectors. As a matter of fact, PUSA is now liaising with concerned bodies to write in to echo with this request. It is hoped that the hearing may be able to materialize at your earliest arrangement.
