

Veterinary Surgeons Registration (Amendment) Bill 2014

Debate and voting arrangements

First debate	: Clauses with no amendment – Clauses 1, 2, 4 to 8, 10, 13, 14, 15, 17, 18, 20 and 21
Voting	: To vote on the above clauses standing part of the Bill
Second debate:	Clauses with amendments proposed by Secretary for Food and Health (“SFH”) – Clauses 3, 9, 11, 12, 16 and 19
Joint debate on the original clauses and the amendments thereto. <u>Clauses 11, 12(2) and (6), and 19</u> - to stipulate that when a decision is to be made by a preliminary investigation committee (“PIC”) on whether a complaint should be referred to an inquiry committee (“IC”), such a decision must be unanimous, or if the PIC is unable to reach a unanimous decision, it must refer the complaint to the Veterinary Surgeons Board, which may decide whether to refer the complaint to an IC; and <u>Clauses 3(3), 9(2), 16 and 16(3)</u> - to make technical and consequential amendments.	
Voting	: To vote on the above amendments together
