**Report No. 19/14-15 of the House Committee on Consideration of
Subsidiary Legislation and Other Instruments**

Purpose

This report gives the outcome of the consideration of the House Committee on subsidiary legislation the period for amendment of which will expire at the Council meeting of 13 May 2015.

Subsidiary legislation considered

2. The House Committee has considered the following items of subsidiary legislation -

3. The House Committee formed a subcommittee at its meeting on 10 April 2015 to study items (1) and (2) in detail. The Subcommittee made a verbal report at the House Committee meeting on 24 April 2015, and provided Members with a written report vide LC Paper No. CB(4)919/14-15 on 6 May 2015.

4. In respect of items (3) to (5), the House Committee considered it not necessary to form any subcommittee to study these three items of subsidiary legislation.

Note: The House Committee formed a subcommittee to study the following two items of subsidiary legislation at its meeting on 17 April 2015. The President has given permission for Hon Cyd HO, Chairman of the Subcommittee, to move a proposed resolution at the Council meeting of 13 May 2015 to extend the period for amending these two items of subsidiary legislation to the Council meeting of 3 June 2015. Details of these two items of subsidiary legislation are as follows –
