**Report No. 23/14-15 of the House Committee on Consideration of

Purpose

This report gives the outcome of the consideration of the House Committee on subsidiary legislation the period for amendment of which will expire at the Council meeting of 17 June 2015.

3. The House Committee formed three subcommittees at its meeting on 22 May 2015 to study respectively items (9) and (10), item (11), as well as item (12) in detail. The three Subcommittees made verbal reports at the House Committee meeting on 5 June 2015. The first and third Subcommittees provided Members with written reports respectively vide LC Paper Nos. CB(1)957/14-15 and CB(4)1128/14-15 on 8 June 2015. The second Subcommittee provided Members with a written report vide LC Paper No. CB(1)966/14-15 on 10 June 2015.

4. In respect of items (1) to (8), the House Committee considered it not necessary to form any subcommittee to study these eight items of subsidiary legislation.

Note: The House Committee formed two subcommittees to study the following four items of subsidiary legislation at its meetings on 22 May and 5 June 2015 respectively. The Council passed on 10 June 2015 two resolutions moved respectively by Hon Frankie YICK, Chairman of the relevant Subcommittee, and Hon Andrew LEUNG, Chairman of the House Committee, to extend the period for amending these four items of subsidiary legislation to the Council meeting of 8 July 2015. Details are as follows –
