- 1. Updates on the Kai Tak Cruise Terminal** October 2014

The Administration will update the Panel on the latest progress of the Kai Tak Cruise Terminal since its commissioning in mid-2013 (including the shipcall arrangement and business development of the terminal, as well as the initiatives to promote cruise tourism etc.).
- 2. Amendment to the Schedule of Port Control (Cargo Working Areas) Regulations (Cap. 81A) on fees and charges** October 2014

The Administration proposes to increase the fee of the Operation Area Permit of cargo working areas in phases, from the existing charge of \$10 to \$11 per metre square per month. The Administration plans to table the relevant subsidiary legislation at the Legislative Council ("LegCo") in early December 2014.
- 3. Issues relevant to the Competition Ordinance** November 2014

The Administration will brief the Panel on the work relevant to the implementation of the Competition Ordinance.
- 4. Subsidiary legislation to implement International Maritime Convention** December 2014

The Administration will brief Panel members on legislative proposals to make/amend four regulations under the Merchant Shipping (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Ordinance (Cap. 413) to implement: (i) amendments to Annexes I, IV and V to the "International Convention for the Prevention of Pollution from Ships, 1973, as modified by the Protocol of 1978 relating thereto" and (ii) the "International Convention on the Control of Harmful Anti-fouling System on Ships, 2001".

- 5. Annual tariff reviews with the two power companies** December 2014
- Pursuant to the Scheme of Control Agreements (SCAs) with the two power companies, a tariff review will be conducted by the Government and the respective power company towards the end of each year. The two power companies will announce their tariff for 2015 after the review and explain their cases to the Panel if there is any adjustment.
- 6. Salvage, removal and disposal of the wreck "興海 668" and its cargo of steel plate** Fourth quarter of 2014 (subject to the result of a tender exercise)
- The Mainland cargo vessel "興海 668" sank near the busy East Lamma Channel on 21 October 2008. Panel members will be briefed on the funding to carry out the works for the salvage, removal and disposal of the wreck of "興海 668" and its cargo of steel plate.
- 7. The development plan for Hong Kong Port (HKP) and related port enhancement measures** December 2014/
January 2015
- Consultants have largely completed the two consultancy studies viz "Preliminary Feasibility Study for Container Terminal 10 at Southwest Tsing Yi" and the "Study on the Strategic Development Plan of Hong Kong Port (HKP) 2030". The Administration will brief the Panel on the major recommendations of the studies and the development plan for HKP, including enhancement measures for existing port facilities, the review of port back-up land and barge berthing provisions at Kwai Tsing Container Port, with a view to enhancing the overall competitiveness of the HKP.
- 8. Logistics development** End 2014 / first quarter of 2015
- At the meeting on 28 March 2011, Hon Miriam LAU requested the Administration to brief the Panel on the implementation of the National Twelfth Five-year (12-5) Plan, in particular further development of Hong Kong as a shipping centre and logistics hub.
- At the meeting on 13 October 2011, Hon Miriam LAU expressed concern about the slow progress in developing the logistics cluster in Kwai Tsing area as reported in the

2011-2012 Policy Address.

At the meeting on 16 October 2012, Hon Michael TIEN requested that the Administration should provide information on the comparison of the logistics facilities of Hong Kong and other cities in the Pearl River Delta. The Administration agrees to brief the Panel in due course.

Proposed timing for discussion**14. Future development of the electricity market in Hong Kong**

First half of 2015

The current SCAs signed between the Government and the two power companies will expire in 2018. The Government will consult the public on the future development of the electricity market in Hong Kong.

15. Proposed establishment of a new statutory body to provide dedicated resources for promoting the development of the maritime industry in Hong Kong

Second quarter / third quarter of 2015

With regard to a consultancy recommendation that Hong Kong should set up a new statutory body with dedicated resources for promoting the development of the maritime industry in Hong Kong, the Administration will brief Panel members on the latest progress on the formulation of specific functions, structure and financing arrangement for the proposed body. The Administration plans to present the relevant bill to LegCo in 2016.

16. Outcome of the review on public cargo working areas

July 2015

The Administration will brief Panel members on the progress of the review on public cargo working areas conducted by the Marine Department, and propose the next steps of work.

17. Purchase of air traffic management system Autotrac 3 by the Civil Aviation Department

Proposed by Hon Albert CHAN at the meeting on 26 May 2014. The Administration's response (LC Paper No. CB(1)1898/13-14(01) to the submission dated 23 May 2014 from a member of the public (LC Paper No. CB(1)1620/13-14(01)) expressing views on the subject was issued to members on 4 August 2014.

18. Proposed amendments to the civil aviation legislation relating to the investigation of accidents

The Administration will brief Panel members on the proposed legislative amendments which seek to implement the latest requirements promulgated by the International Civil Aviation Organization.

discussion****19. Lei Yue Mun Waterfront Enhancement Project** To be confirmed

The Administration will consult members on the project to enhance the attractiveness of Lei Yue Mun (LYM) as a popular tourism spot through further improving the facilities along the LYM waterfront area.

20. Overall planning of tourism infrastructures and relevant support measures To be confirmed

At the meeting of the Panel on Development on 14 October 2010, Hon Paul TSE cited the effort of the government of Singapore in the development of Sentosa into a tourist attraction and commented that the Administration should take the lead in the overall planning of tourism infrastructure in Hong Kong.

The Chairman of the Panel on Economic Development in the 2011-2012 session agreed to include the item in this list as planning of tourism infrastructure is led by the Commerce and Economic Development Bureau.

The Administration has been requested to report on the progress in developing new tourist attractions and, where appropriate, on measures being taken to address concerns about taxi scams, the operation of the SkyPier and the Security Bureau's Outbound Travel Alert System.

At the meeting on 16 October 2012, Hon CHAN Han-pan requested the Administration to provide information on the development of ancillary facilities for the various tourist spots. The Administration advised that it would include details of the relevant ancillary facilities when it briefed the Panel on individual tourism projects, e.g. the Kai Tak Cruise Terminal, the Ocean Park and Hong Kong Disneyland projects.

21. Ocean Park's admission price adjustment To be confirmed

Hon TANG Ka-piu wrote to the Panel Chairman on 3 July 2013 expressing concern about the admission price adjustment of the Ocean Park and the Administration provided a written response to the letter on 16 July 2013 (LC Papers Nos. CB(1)1554/12-13(01) and (02) respectively). The Panel

agreed to include the item in this list at the meeting on 22 July 2013.

22. Licensing and regulation of low cost carriers

Proposed by Hon Dennis KWOK at the meeting on 10 October 2013. The Administration's paper in respect of the operation of low-cost carriers in Hong Kong (LC Paper No. CB(1)1809/12-13(02)) provided in response to Hon KWOK's earlier letter on the subject was issued on 18 September 2013.
