Receiving public views on "Measures to tackle under-occupation in public rental housing estates"	17.6.2014	<p>The Administration to reflect to the Hong Kong Housing Authority that it should conduct the following reviews and inform the Panel of the review outcome –</p> <p>(a) to review the under-occupation policy with a view to exempting those households which have been rehoused to larger units due to special circumstances, in particular the previous tenants of public rental housing estates built using seawater and tenants affected by redevelopment and who were rehoused to units in harmony blocks; and</p> <p>(b) for households that have become Prioritized Under-occupied households as a result of the death of their family members, to review whether the six-month period currently allowed for such households to continue to stay in their existing units is too short.</p>	Response awaited.
