**Panel on Manpower  
Information requested by Members at the meeting of 16 December 2014**

At the meeting of the Panel on Manpower on 16 December 2014, a Member requested the Government to provide information on the residential districts of job seekers who have visited Tung Chung Job Centre. Our reply is as follows.

From 20 October 2014 when the Tung Chung Job Centre commenced operation to 30 November 2014, a total of 3 508 visitors were recorded. As we only require job seekers who register for employment services to provide personal information, we do not have information on the residential districts of other visitors to the Tung Chung Job Centre. Apart from visiting any job centre to register for our employment services, job seekers who reside on the Lantau Island may register at the relevant website of the Labour Department.

As at 30 November 2014, a total of 244 job seekers who were residents in Tung Chung or nearby areas had registered for the employment services of the Labour Department through the job centres or the relevant website. A breakdown of these registered job seekers by their residential districts is provided below.
