Action

I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman for the 2014-2015 session

(Appendices III and IV to LC Paper No. CB(2)5/14-15)

Election of Chairman

Mr IP Kwok-him, the incumbent Chairman, called for nominations for the chairmanship of the Panel for the 2014-2015 session. Mr James TO was nominated by Ms Cyd HO and the nomination was seconded by Mr Alan LEONG. Mr James TO accepted the nomination. Mr IP called for other nominations.

- 2. <u>Mr IP Kwok-him</u> was nominated by <u>Dr CHIANG Lai-wan</u> and the nomination was seconded by <u>Mr WONG Kwok-kin</u>. <u>Mr IP Kwok-him</u> accepted the nomination. As both the incumbent Chairman and the incumbent Deputy Chairman were nominated for the office, Mr CHAN Kam-lam, member of the highest precedence among members present, took over from Mr IP Kwok-him to preside over the election. <u>Mr CHAN</u> Kam-lam called for other nominations.
- 3. As there was no other nomination, <u>Mr CHAN Kam-lam</u> announced a vote by secret ballot. After all members had cast their votes, <u>Mr CHAN Kam-lam</u> invited Ms Cyd HO and Dr CHIANG Lai-wan who had nominated the two candidates to monitor the counting of votes.
- 4. <u>Mr CHAN Kam-lam</u> announced that 10 and 20 members voted for Mr James TO and Mr IP Kwok-him respectively. <u>Mr CHAN Kam-lam</u> declared Mr IP Kwok-him elected as the Chairman of the Panel for the 2014-2015 session. Mr IP then took the chair.

Election of Deputy Chairman

- 5. <u>The Chairman</u> called for nominations for the deputy chairmanship of the Panel. Mr James TO was nominated by <u>Mr Kenneth LEUNG</u> and the nomination was seconded by <u>Ms Cyd HO</u>. <u>Mr James TO</u> accepted the nomination. The Chairman called for other nominations.
- 6. Mr NG Leung-sing was nominated by Mr CHAN Kin-por and the nomination was seconded by Mr YIU Si-wing. Mr NG Leung-sing accepted the nomination. The Chairman called for other nominations.
- 7. As there was no other nomination, <u>the Chairman</u> announced a vote by secret ballot. After all members had cast their votes, <u>the Chairman</u> invited Mr Kenneth LEUNG and Mr CHAN Kin-por who had nominated the two candidates to monitor the counting of votes.
- 8. <u>The Chairman</u> announced that 10 and 20 members voted for Mr James TO and Mr NG Leung-sing respectively. <u>The Chairman</u> declared Mr NG Leung-sing elected as Deputy Chairman of the Panel for the 2014-2015 session.

II. Schedule of meetings for the 2014-2015 session

9. <u>Members</u> agreed that future regular meetings of the Panel would be held on the first Tuesday of each month at 2:30 pm. As the first Tuesday of April 2015 was a public holiday, <u>members</u> agreed to reschedule the regular meeting of April to Friday, 10 April 2015 at 10:45 am.

(*Post-meeting note*: The meeting schedule was issued to members vide LC Paper No. CB(2)30/14-15 on 9 October 2014.)

III. Items for discussion at the next meeting

(Appendices V and VI to LC Paper No. CB(2)5/14-15)

- 10. <u>Members</u> agreed that the following items proposed by the Administration would be discussed at the next regular meeting to be held on 4 November 2014 at 2:30 pm -
 - (a) Proposed extension for three years of a supernumerary Administrative Officer Staff Grade C post in the Narcotics Division of the Security Bureau; and
 - (b) Latest developments in the provision of rehabilitative services by the Correctional Services Department.
- 11. Mr James TO said that he had recently written a letter to the Chairman requesting the holding of a special meeting as soon as possible to discuss the Police's handling of recent public assemblies. He expressed regret that a special meeting had not been held to discuss the subject. Although the President of the Legislative Council had approved the moving of an adjournment motion on "The handling of people's assemblies by the SAR Government and the Hong Kong Police since 26 September this year" at the Council meeting originally scheduled for 8 October 2014, which would be held on 15 October 2014, Mr TO considered that the discussion of the subject at a Panel meeting would provide members with more time to raise questions and follow up the Administration's response. He considered that a special meeting should still be held to discuss the subject. Ms Emily LAU expressed support for Mr TO's request and said that the request should be considered having regard to the views of members of the public.

- 12. <u>Ms Claudia MO</u> considered that as there were still uncertainties regarding whether a Council meeting could be held on the forthcoming Wednesday, a special meeting of the Panel should be held as soon as possible to discuss the subject, including the use of tear gas by the Police. Her view was shared by Mr CHAN Chi-chuen.
- 13. <u>Dr CHIANG Lai-wan</u> said that consideration could be given to discussing the subject at the next regular Panel meeting in November 2014. <u>The Chairman</u> said that a special meeting had not been held to discuss the subject because the President of the Legislative Council had approved the moving of an adjournment motion on the subject at the Council meeting originally scheduled for 8 October 2014, which would be held on 15 October 2014. He would further consult members on Mr TO's request.

(*Post-meeting note*: On the instruction of the Chairman, a special meeting was scheduled for 27 October 2014 at 2:45 pm to discuss "Police's handling of public assemblies since 26 September 2014".)
