#### Proposed timing for discussion

- 1. Establishment of a declaration and disclosure system for the physical cross-boundary transportation of currency and bearer negotiable instruments** To be confirmed

The Administration intends to brief the Panel on the details of establishing a declaration and disclosure system for the physical cross-boundary transportation of currency and bearer negotiable instruments, pursuant to the relevant international standards on anti-money laundering and counter financing of terrorism set by the Financial Action Task Force.

- 2. Co-location arrangement at the control point for the Guangzhou-Shenzhen-Hong Kong Express Rail Link ("XRL")** To be advised by THB

Item proposed by Hon Dennis KWOK, whose letter on the subject had been circulated to members vide LC Paper No. CB(2)707/12-13 on 27 February 2013. At the meeting on 1 March 2013, members agreed that the subject be discussed at a future meeting. Members also agreed that members of the Panel on Administration of Justice and Legal Services and representatives from the Department of Justice would be invited to attend when the subject was discussed.

The Administration advised that co-location arrangement at the control point concerned was part and parcel of the XRL project spearheaded by the Transport and Housing Bureau (THB), which would provide information to the Panel on Transport on the co-location arrangement of immigration and customs facilities at the control point as part and parcel of the XRL project in due course.

- 3. Contingency plan for nuclear incidents near Hong Kong** To be confirmed

Item proposed on 10 October 2013 by Dr Hon Kenneth CHAN, who expressed concern about nuclear safety and the Administration's contingency plan in the event of a nuclear incident near Hong Kong.

The Administration intends to brief the Panel on the relevant notification mechanism and contingency plan in due course.

- 4. Use of military sites and implementation of the Garrison Law in Hong Kong** To be confirmed

Item proposed by Dr Hon Kenneth CHAN on 10 October 2013. Dr CHAN also proposed in his letter of 27 November 2013 (LC Paper No. CB(2)399/13-14(01)) the discussion of legal liability under the Garrison Law.

Hon Frederick FUNG raised a question on the review of the use of military sites at the Council meeting of 9 October 2013.

Two referrals from the Public Complaints Office on rezoning a site at the Central waterfront from "Open Space" to "Military use" were circulated to members vide LC Paper No. CB(2)745/13-14 on 22 January 2014.
