Thank you for your letter dated 5 December 2014 regarding the captioned.

Hon Claudia MO's letter concerns the issue of illegal hunting of wild animals. As the issue comes under the policy purview of the Environment Bureau and the Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department, we take the liberty to forward your letter to them for reply direct to the Panel.

As regards the mechanism of the Hong Kong Police Force (Police) for handling items suspected to be explosives, on receipt of any report of objects suspected to be explosive or dangerous, Police will send officers to attend the scene to confirm the source. Once confirmed, Police will immediately cordon off and evacuate the area where the suspicious object is located. The extent of the cordon and evacuation would depend on the size and nature of the suspicious object. The duty Bomb Disposal Officer will then be tasked to attend the scene to render safe all finds of suspicious objects.
