2. Replacement of tunnel lighting system in the Kai Tak Tunnel

Proposed by the Administration. The Administration would like to inform members of the Government's proposal to replace the tunnel lighting system in the Kai Tak Tunnel.

3. Public Transport Strategy Study ("PTSS") - Seating capacity of public light buses ("PLB")

Proposed by the Administration. The Administration would like to assess the present situation and listen to views of the Panel. The views so collected will be analyzed under the Role and Positioning Review of the PTSS to see if the proposal is feasible and desirable, having regard to the long-term operational and financial implications for the PLB trade, other public transport services and road traffic management.

15. Cycling safety and consultancy study on cycling networks and parking facilities in existing new towns

The Administration commissioned a consultancy study to review the existing cycle track networks in nine existing new towns. The study would identify deficiencies of the existing cycle track networks, propose remedial measures for improvements, and recommend an implementation programme for the proposed improvement works. The Administration plans to brief the Panel of the findings of the consultancy study upon its completion.

At the Panel meetings on 7 November 2011 and 16 October 2012 respectively, members considered that the issue of "cycling safety" should be revisited by the Panel and the Administration should consider formulating a policy to promote the use of bicycles as a means of transport in Hong Kong.
