**Prevention and Control of Disease (Amendment) (No. 2)
Regulation 2014**

(Made by the Secretary for Food and Health under section 7 of the Prevention and Control of Disease Ordinance (Cap. 599))

1. Prevention and Control of Disease Regulation amended

The Prevention and Control of Disease Regulation (Cap. 599 sub. leg. A) is amended as set out in section 2.

2. Section 56 amended (specified diseases)

(1) Section 56, definition of *specified disease*, paragraph (b)—

Repeal

“and”.

(2) Section 56, definition of *specified disease*, paragraph (c)—

Repeal the full stop

Substitute a semicolon.

(3) Section 56, definition of *specified disease*, after paragraph (c)—

Add

“(d) Plague;

(e) Smallpox; and

(f) Viral haemorrhagic fever.”.
