Explanatory Note

This Regulation amends the Schedule to the Chiropractors Registration (Fees) Regulation (Cap. 428 sub. leg. A) to increase the fees payable for—

- (a) the application for registration as a registered chiropractor;
- (b) the restoration of an applicant's name to the register of registered chiropractors;
- (c) the issue of a certificate of registration;
- (d) the application for issue or renewal of a practising certificate for a registered chiropractor; or
- (e) a certificate signed by the Secretary to the Chiropractors Council certifying matters in relation to entries in the register or holders of practising certificates.
