Explanatory Note

The object of this Regulation is to amend Schedule 2 to the Registration of Persons Regulations (Cap. 177 sub. leg. A) to revise the fees payable for—

- (a) replacing a lost or destroyed identity card under regulation 13 of the Regulations;
- (b) replacing a damaged or defaced identity card under regulation 13 of the Regulations;
- (c) replacing an identity card requiring alteration under regulation 14(1)(a) of the Regulations; and
- (d) furnishing a certificate or a certified copy under section 10 of the Registration of Persons Ordinance (Cap. 177).
