**LCQ22: Consultation work in relation to updating
the electorate of functional constituencies**

With reference to your written reply to the Legislative Council regarding the question of Hon Charles Peter MOK on 10 June 2015, we would like to respond as follows:

"According to Appendix B of Registration in the Information Technology Functional Constituency ("FC") and Election Committee ("EC") Subsector, Item (6), only members of the IET Hong Kong, who are Chartered Engineers or Corporate Members of the IEE Hong Kong before 15 October 2002, are eligible to register as voters of the Information Technology (IT) FC and EC subsector.

As all Honorary Fellows, Fellows and Members of the IET in Hong Kong, regardless of its professional registration as Chartered Engineers, are eligible to vote in the General Meetings of the IET Hong Kong, it is not reasonable to exclude those members of the IET who do not have any professional registration, from being eligible for registration as a voter of the IT FC and EC subsector.

Therefore, the IET Hong Kong requests for amendment of the Ordinance to allow all members of the IET Hong Kong who have voting rights in General Meetings of the IET Hong Kong to register as voters of the Information Technology FC and EC subsector."
