# I. Confirmation of the minutes of the 2nd meeting held on 23 October 2015

#### **II.** Matters arising

# Report by the Chairman on his meeting with the Chief Secretary for Administration

2. <u>The Chairman</u> said that the Chief Secretary for Administration ("CS") had indicated that she and the relevant public officers would be happy to attend a further special House Committee ("HC") meeting to answer Members' questions on the subjects of population policy and lead

in drinking water incidents. CS had also advised that the Commission on Poverty chaired by her would launch a public consultation exercise on retirement protection in December 2015 and should HC consider it necessary, she would be happy to attend another special HC meeting on this subject. CS's Office would liaise with the Legislative Council Secretariat on the meeting dates.

### **III.** Business arising from previous Council meetings

#### Legal Service Division report on subsidiary legislation and non-legislative instrument gazetted on 23 October 2015 (LC Paper No. LS4/15-16)

3. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>Legal Adviser</u> ("LA") briefed Members on the Legal Service Division ("LSD") report on the 12 items of subsidiary legislation (i.e. L.N. 202 to L.N. 213) and one item of non-legislative instrument (i.e. The Fifth Technical Memorandum for Allocation of Emission Allowances in Respect of Specified Licences ("the Fifth Technical Memorandum") (S.S. No.5 to Gazette No.43/2015)) which were gazetted on 23 October 2015 and tabled in Council on 28 October 2015. <u>Members</u> noted that LSD was still scrutinizing the Banking (Capital) (Amendment) Rules 2015 (L.N. 212).

4. Regarding the Census and Statistics (2016 Population Census) Order (L.N. 208), <u>LA</u> informed Members that LSD was seeking clarification from the Administration in relation to certain aspects of the Order and would make a further report, if necessary. <u>Ms Cyd HO</u> considered it necessary to form a subcommittee to study the Order in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. Ms Emily LAU and Ms Cyd HO agreed to join the proposed subcommittee.

5. <u>Mr Dennis KWOK</u> considered it necessary to form a subcommittee to study the Fifth Technical Memorandum in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. Mr WU Chi-wai and Mr Dennis KWOK agreed to join the proposed subcommittee.

6. <u>Members</u> did not raise any question on the remaining 11 items of subsidiary legislation (i.e. L.N. 202 to L.N. 207 and L.N. 209 to L.N. 213).

7. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded Members that the deadline for amending these items of subsidiary legislation and non-legislative instrument would be the Council meeting of 25 November 2015, or that of 16 December 2015 if extended by a resolution of the Council. (*Post-meeting note* : LSD informed the Clerk on 4 November 2015 that it had completed the scrutiny of the Banking (Capital) (Amendment) Rules 2015 (L.N. 212) and no difficulties had been identified in the legal and drafting aspects of the Rules.)

8. <u>The Chairman</u> informed Members that the meeting would start at 11:00 am and be suspended at around 8:00 pm on Wednesday, 4 November 2015. He reminded Members to indicate their intention by 5:00 pm on Tuesday, 3 November 2015 should they wish to speak on any of these items of subsidiary legislation.

19. <u>The Chairman</u>, in his capacity as Chairman of the Subcommittee, briefed Members on the deliberations of the Subcommittee as detailed in its report. <u>Members</u> noted that the Subcommittee supported the six items of subsidiary legislation.
