I. Confirmation of the minutes of the 6th meeting held on 20 November 2015

II. **Matters arising**

Report by the Chairman on his meeting with the Chief Secretary for Administration

2. The Chairman said that there was nothing special to report.

III. Business arising from previous Council meetings

- (a) Legal Service Division reports on bills referred to the House Committee in accordance with Rule 54(4)
 - (i) Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes (Amendment) Bill 2015

(LC Paper No. LS12/15-16)

- 3. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>Legal Adviser</u> ("LA") briefed Members on the report prepared by the Legal Service Division ("LSD") on the Bill.
- 4. <u>Ms Cyd HO</u> considered it necessary to form a Bills Committee to study the Bill in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. Ms Cyd HO and Mr SIN Chung-kai agreed to join the proposed Bills Committee.
 - (ii) Deposit Protection Scheme (Amendment) Bill 2015 (LC Paper No. LS14/15-16)
- 5. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>LA</u> briefed Members on the LSD report on the Bill.
- 6. <u>Mr SIN Chung-kai</u> considered it necessary to form a Bills Committee to study the Bill in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. Mr SIN Chung-kai agreed to join the proposed Bills Committee.
- (b) Legal Service Division report on subsidiary legislation gazetted on 20 November 2015 and tabled in Council on 25 November 2015

(LC Paper No. LS11/15-16)

- 7. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>LA</u> briefed Members on the LSD report on the three items of subsidiary legislation (i.e. L.N. 227, L.N. 228 and L.N. 230) which were gazetted on 20 November 2015 and tabled in Council on 25 November 2015.
- 8. <u>Mr SIN Chung-kai</u> considered it necessary to form a subcommittee to study the Securities and Futures (Contracts Limits and Reportable Positions) (Amendment) Rules 2015 (L.N. 228) in detail. <u>Members agreed</u>. Mr Christopher CHEUNG and Mr SIN Chung-kai agreed to join the proposed subcommittee.

- 9. <u>Members</u> did not raise any question on the other two items of subsidiary legislation.
- 10. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded Members that the deadline for amending these items of subsidiary legislation would be the Council meeting of 16 December 2015, or that of 13 January 2016 if extended by a resolution of the Council.

IV. Further business for the Council meeting of 2 December 2015

Meeting arrangement for the Council meeting of 2 December 2015

11. The Chairman informed Members that the meeting would start at 11:00 am and be suspended at around 8:00 pm on Wednesday, 2 December 2015. The meeting would resume at 9:00 am on Thursday, 3 December 2015 and be adjourned after conclusion of all the business on the Agenda.

Tabling of papers

Report No. 6/15-16 of the House Committee on Consideration of Subsidiary Legislation and Other Instruments

(LC Paper No. CB(2)332/15-16)

- 12. <u>The Chairman</u> said that the Report covered 19 items of subsidiary legislation and the period for amending those items would expire at the Council meeting of 2 December 2015.
- 13. The Chairman informed Members that as several Members had indicated their intention to speak on seven items of the above subsidiary legislation, he would, in his capacity as the Chairman of the House Committee ("HC"), move a motion to take note of the Report in relation to these seven items of subsidiary legislation at the Council meeting.
- 14. The Chairman further said that as the motion related to more than one item of subsidiary legislation, he proposed that the debate on the seven items be divided into two sessions, one covering the five Commencement Notices made under sections 73 and 73A of the Legal Practitioners Ordinance (Cap. 159) (L.N. 161 to L.N. 165) and the other covering the Building (Standards of Sanitary Fitments, Plumbing, Drainage Works and Latrines) (Amendment) Regulation 2015 (L.N. 191) and the Building (Administration) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulation 2015 (L.N. 192). Members agreed.

V. Business for the Council meeting of 9 December 2015

- 15. <u>The Chairman</u> said that 22 questions (six oral and 16 written) had been scheduled for the meeting.
- (b) <u>Bill First Reading and moving of Second Reading</u>
- 16. <u>The Chairman</u> said that no notice had been received yet.
- (c) Bill resumption of debate on Second Reading, Committee Stage and Third Reading

17. The Chairman said that the resumption of the Second Reading debate on the Bill would be dealt with at the Council meeting. In response to Mr CHAN Chi-chuen's enquiry, the Chairman advised that Members would be informed of the meeting arrangements at the next HC meeting.

Two proposed resolutions to be moved by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 5(3)(b) of the Public Bus Services Ordinance (Cap. 230) in relation to the following two bus companies:

- (i) Citybus Limited; and
- (ii) New Lantao Bus Company (1973) Limited

- 18. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>LA</u> briefed Members on the LSD report on the above two proposed resolutions.
- 19. <u>Mr WU Chi-wai</u> considered it necessary to form a subcommittee to study the proposed resolutions in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. Mr WU Chi-wai and Mr TANG Ka-piu agreed to join the proposed subcommittee.

20. The Chairman informed Members that in line with the established practice and the arrangement agreed with the Administration, the Administration would be requested to withdraw its notices for moving the two proposed resolutions so as to allow sufficient time for the subcommittee to scrutinize the proposed resolutions.

- 21. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded Members that the deadline for giving notice of amendments, if any, to the motions was Wednesday, 2 December 2015.

Report of HC on Consideration of Subsidiary Legislation

22. The Chairman invited Members to note the list tabled at the meeting (LC Paper No. CB(3)186/15-16), which contained two items of subsidiary legislation. The period for amending those items would expire at the Council meeting of 9 December 2015. He reminded Members to indicate their intention by 5:00 pm on Tuesday, 1 December 2015, should they wish to speak on any of these items of subsidiary legislation.

VI. Position on Bills Committees and subcommittees

23. <u>The Chairman</u> said that as at 26 November 2015, there were 11 Bills Committees, eight subcommittees under HC and seven subcommittees on policy issues under Panels in action. Five subcommittees on policy issues under Panels were on the waiting list.
