Action

I. Confirmation of the minutes of the 23rd meeting held on 6 May 2016 (*LC Paper No. CB*(2)1456/15-16)

The minutes were confirmed.

II. Matters arising

Report by the Chairman on his meeting with the Chief Secretary for Administration

2. <u>The Chairman</u> said that there was nothing special to report.

III. Business arising from previous Council meetings

Legal Service Division report on subsidiary legislation gazetted on <u>6 May 2016 and tabled in Council on 11 May 2016</u>

(LC Paper No. LS52/15-16)

3. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>Legal Adviser</u> briefed Members on the report prepared by the Legal Service Division on the nine items of subsidiary legislation (i.e. L.N. 52 to L.N. 60) which were gazetted on 6 May 2016 and tabled in Council on 11 May 2016.

4. <u>Mr Frankie YICK</u> considered it necessary to form a subcommittee to study in detail the four regulations made under the Merchant Shipping (Safety) Ordinance (Cap. 369) (i.e. the Merchant Shipping (Safety) (Signals of Distress and Prevention of Collisions) (Amendment) Regulation 2016 (L.N. 53), the Merchant Shipping (Safety) (Carriage of Cargoes) (Amendment) Regulation 2016 (L.N. 54), the Merchant Shipping (Safety) (IMSBC Code) Regulation (L.N. 55), and the Merchant Shipping (Safety) (High Speed Craft) (Amendment) Regulation 2016 (L.N. 56)). <u>Members</u> agreed. Mr Frankie YICK and Mr WONG Kwok-kin agreed to join the proposed subcommittee.

5. <u>Mr Frankie YICK</u> also considered it necessary to form a subcommittee to study the Waste Disposal (Charges for Disposal of Construction Waste) Regulation (Amendment of Schedules) Notice 2016 (L.N. 60) in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. Mr Frankie YICK and Dr KWOK Ka-ki agreed to join the proposed subcommittee.

6. <u>Members</u> did not raise any question on the remaining four items of subsidiary legislation (i.e. L.N. 52, and L.N. 57 to L.N. 59).

7. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded Members that the deadline for amending the nine items of subsidiary legislation would be the Council meeting of 8 June 2016, or that of 29 June 2016 if extended by a resolution of the Council.

IV. Further business for the Council meeting of 18 May 2016

14. <u>The Chairman</u> said that the Members' motions which had been scheduled for debate at previous Council meetings would stand over until the following Council meetings, with each Council meeting dealing with two such motions without legislative effect.

15. <u>The Chairman</u> invited Members to note the list tabled at the meeting (LC Paper No. CB(3)587/15-16), which contained two items of subsidiary legislation. He reminded Members to indicate their intention by 5:00 pm on Tuesday, 17 May 2016, should they wish to speak on any of these items of subsidiary legislation.
