## III. Business arising from previous Council meetings

# Legal Service Division report on subsidiary legislation gazetted on 20 May 2016 and tabled in Council on 25 May 2016

(LC Paper No. LS55/15-16)

- 3. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>Legal Adviser</u> briefed Members on the report prepared by the Legal Service Division on the 26 items of subsidiary legislation (i.e. L.N. 64 to L.N. 89) which were gazetted on 20 May 2016 and tabled in Council on 25 May 2016.
- 4. Mr Tommy CHEUNG considered it necessary to form a subcommittee to study the Public Health (Animals and Birds) (Animal Traders) (Amendment) Regulation 2016 (L.N. 64) and the Specification of Public Offices (Amendment) Notice 2016 (L.N. 68) in detail. Members agreed. The following Members agreed to join the subcommittee: Mr Tommy CHEUNG, Ms Cyd HO, Mr CHAN Hak-kan, Ms Claudia MO, Mr Gary FAN and Dr CHIANG Lai-wan.
- 5. <u>Mr James TO</u> considered it necessary to form a subcommittee to study the 14 regulations made under the Merchant Shipping (Seafarers) Ordinance (Cap. 478) (i.e. L.N. 69 to L.N. 82) in detail. <u>Members agreed</u>. Mr James TO agreed to join the proposed subcommittee.
- 6. <u>Dr CHIANG Lai-wan</u> considered it necessary to form a subcommittee to study the Public Health and Municipal Services (Fees and Charges) (Museums) (Amendment) Regulation 2016 (L.N. 84) in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. Mr YIU Si-wing, Mr IP Kin-yuen and Dr CHIANG Lai-wan agreed to join the subcommittee.
- 7. <u>Dr Fernando CHEUNG</u> considered it necessary to form a subcommittee to study the Immigration (Unauthorized Entrants) (Amendment) Order 2016 (L.N. 66) in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. The following Members agreed to join the subcommittee: Ms Cyd HO, Mr IP Kwok-him, Mr Dennis KWOK and Dr Fernando CHEUNG.
- 8. <u>Members</u> did not raise any question on the remaining eight items of subsidiary legislation (i.e. L.N. 65, L.N. 67, L.N. 83, and L.N. 85 to L.N. 89).
- 9. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded Members that the deadline for amending the 26 items of subsidiary legislation would be the Council meeting of 22 June 2016, or that of 13 July 2016 if extended by a resolution of the Council.

### VI. Reports of Bills Committees and subcommittees

# Report of the Bills Committee on Inland Revenue (Amendment) Bill 2016

(LC Paper No. CB(1)963/15-16)

- 20. The Chairman, in his capacity as Chairman of the Bills Committee, briefed Members on the deliberations of the Bills Committee as detailed in its report. The Chairman informed Members that the Bills Committee and the Administration would not propose any Committee stage amendments ("CSAs") to the Bill, and the Bills Committee had no objection to the resumption of the Second Reading debate on the Bill at the Council meeting of 8 June 2016. Members noted that Mr James TO had indicated his intention to propose CSAs to the proposed offence provision relating to the making of a self-certification that was misleading, false or incorrect in a material particular, and Mr Kenneth LEUNG had also indicated that he might propose CSAs in relation to the proposed offences of service providers.
- 21. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded Members that the deadline for giving notice of CSAs, if any, proposed to be moved to the above Bill would be Monday, 30 May 2016.

# VII. Position on Bills Committees and subcommittees
