- 3. The House Committee formed two subcommittees to study items (1) and (2) respectively in detail at its meeting on 30 October 2015. The former Subcommittee made a verbal report at the House Committee meeting on 4 December 2015, and provided Members with a written report vide LC Paper No. CB(1)235/15-16 on 7 December 2015. The latter Subcommittee reported its deliberations at the same House Committee meeting vide LC Paper No. CB(1)238/15-16.
- 4. In respect of items (3) and (4), the House Committee considered it not necessary to form any subcommittee to study these two items of subsidiary legislation.
