Re: Issues related to the implementation of Territory-wide System Assessment

Refer to the special meeting on Sunday, 29 November 2015, at 9:00 am in Conference Room 1 of the Legislative Council Complex for issues related to the implementation of Territory-wide System Assessment (TSA). I, Lee Tsui Shan , have below concerns and suggestions.

Concerns:

- 1) Age of student in primary 3 are in the range of 7-9 years old. They only enter primary school 2 years before TSA assessment. It is a question on reliability of the result form learning on basic competencies. In additional, three years age difference between kids is a big gap. The physical and mental development is a big range among kids. Thus, the data and information about students' strengths and weaknesses is not related to the first 2 years learning by providing school.
- 2) Education system in Hong Kong is allowed weak student in main stream school. The planning and supporting from government should focus on this issue.

Suggestion:

Suggest to use P6 Assessment as the assessment for the evaluation on school performance and resources supporting and planning. As kids was educated by same school in 6 years, it is better to compare the result than only 2 years as TSA in P3
