Majority of primary schools in Hong Kong are funded by the Hong Kong Government and overseen by the Education Bureau. Hong Kong is suffering from the ineffective education system? I am filled with wrath that Mr. Eddie Ng Hak-kim, Secretary for Education, excuses the upcoming Panel on Education meeting at Legco on 29 November due to person reasons. How responsible is the government!

All in all, please abolish the unnecessary TSA in the Hong Kong Education system which ruins the life of students and future Hong Kong.
