<p>2. Franchise for the bus network of the Kowloon Motor Bus Co. (1933) Limited ("KMB")</p> <p>Proposed by the Administration. The Administration plans to consult the Panel on the way of handling the expiry of the franchise for the bus network of KMB in 2017, and invite members' views on the requirements of the new franchise.</p>	18 December 2015
<p>3. Review on fare adjustment arrangement for franchised buses</p> <p>Proposed by the Administration. The Administration plans to brief the Panel on the outcome of the review.</p>	To be confirmed
<p>4. Car parking spaces in urban areas</p> <p>Proposed by Dr KWOK Ka-ki and Mr Frankie YICK at the meeting on 10 October 2013. Dr KWOK and Mr YICK requested to discuss the adequacy of car parking spaces in urban areas, in particular those for heavy and large vehicles.</p>	To be confirmed

<p>Proposed by Mr CHAN Kam-lam in November 2013. Mr CHAN requested the Administration to report the progress of the Central Kowloon Route project to the Panel.</p>	
7. Certificate of Particulars of Motor Vehicle	To be confirmed
<p>To propose legislative amendments for improving the arrangements for issuing Certificate of Particulars of Motor Vehicle in order to enhance the privacy protection for registered owners whose particulars are kept in the register and ensure that the personal data of registered vehicle owners contained in the register is properly used.</p> <p>The item was last discussed at the Panel meeting on 11 July 2011.</p>	
8. Cycling safety and consultancy study on cycling networks and parking facilities in existing new towns	To be confirmed
<p>The Administration commissioned a consultancy study to review the existing cycle track networks in nine existing new towns. The study would identify deficiencies of the existing cycle track networks, propose remedial measures for improvements, and recommend an implementation programme for the proposed improvement works. The Administration plans to brief the Panel of the findings of the consultancy study upon its completion.</p> <p>At the Panel meetings on 7 November 2011 and 16 October 2012 respectively, members considered that the issue of "cycling safety" should be revisited by the Panel and the Administration should consider formulating a policy to promote the use of bicycles as a means of transport in Hong Kong.</p>	
9. Provision of hillside escalator/lift systems	To be confirmed
<p>Proposed by Mr CHAN Han-pan at the meeting on 15 October 2015. Mr CHAN expressed concern over the slow progress of implementing hillside escalator/lift systems.</p>
