# 1. New franchise for the bus network of the Kowloon Motor Bus Co. (1933) Limited – views received through public engagement

June 2016

Proposed by the Administration. The Administration plans to brief the Panel on the views on the new franchise received by the Government during the public engagement exercise.

### 2. MTR fare adjustment for 2016

June 2016

Proposed by the Administration. The Administration plans to brief the Panel on the calculation and outcome of the FAM of the MTR Corporation Limited in 2016. It also provides information on MTRCL's fare promotions in the coming 12 months.

# 3. Public Transport Strategy Study ("PTSS") – Role and Positioning Review on premium taxis and increasing the seating capacity of public light buses

June 2016

Proposed by the Administration. The Administration plans to report to the Panel the progress of the studies on premium taxis, increasing the seating capacity of public light buses, and the review on hire car permit application.

### 4. Review on fare adjustment arrangement for franchised buses

The Administration plans to brief the Panel on the outcome of the review when ready.

### 5. Car parking spaces in urban areas

Proposed by Dr KWOK Ka-ki and Mr Frankie YICK at the meeting on 10 October 2013. Dr KWOK and Mr YICK requested to discuss the adequacy of car parking spaces in urban areas, in particular those for heavy and large vehicles.

### 6. Central Kowloon Route

Proposed by Mr CHAN Kam-lam in November 2013. Mr CHAN requested the Administration to report the progress of the Central Kowloon Route project to the Panel.

### 7. Certificate of Particulars of Motor Vehicle

To be confirmed

The Administration plans to propose legislative amendments for improving the arrangements for issuing Certificate of Particulars of Motor Vehicle in order to enhance the privacy protection for registered owners whose particulars are kept in the register and ensure that the personal data of registered vehicle owners contained in the register is properly used.

The item was last discussed at the Panel meeting on 11 July 2011.

## 8. Cycling safety and consultancy study on cycling networks and parking facilities in existing new towns

To be confirmed

The Administration commissioned a consultancy study to review the existing cycle track networks in nine existing new towns. The study would identify deficiencies of the existing cycle track networks, propose remedial measures for improvements, and recommend an implementation programme for the proposed improvement works. The Administration plans to brief the Panel of the findings of the consultancy study upon its completion.

At the Panel meetings on 7 November 2011 and 16 October 2012 respectively, members considered that the issue of "cycling safety" should be revisited by the Panel and the Administration should consider formulating a policy to promote the use of bicycles as a means of transport in Hong Kong.
