Failure to consider the safety and well being of taxi and mini-bus passengers as well as pedestrians is reckless and perhaps negligent.

I urge you to reconsider and include input from safety experts. From my personal experience, I have witnessed several serious taxi accidents that were -in all likelihood-caused by excessive speed. I have also witnessed a female pedestrian killed (bus 56, Lyttelton Road 2014). There can be no doubt that safety issues must be considered.
