MTR Fare Adjustment for 2016

This paper briefs Members on the calculation and outcome of the Fare Adjustment Mechanism (“FAM”) of the MTR Corporation Limited (“MTRCL”) in 2016. It also provides information on the fare promotions of the MTRCL in the coming 12 months.

FAM as Revised in 2013

2. According to the Operating Agreement entered into between the Government and MTRCL in August 2007, the FAM of MTRCL may be reviewed every five years. The Government and MTRCL conducted the first review in 2012/13 and announced the outcome of the review in April 2013. With respect to the outcome of the review, during the period from 2013 to 2017, the overall fare remains to be adjusted annually according to the original direct-drive formula, while the Productivity Factor is changed from originally 0.1% to 0.6%, lowering the fare adjustment rate by 0.5 percentage point. Details of the formula are –

Overall Fare Adjustment Rate

= (0.5 × change in Composite Consumer Price Index (“CCPI”) in December of the previous year)

+ (0.5 × change in Nominal Wage Index (Transportation Section) in December of the previous year)

– Productivity Factor (value set at 0.6% from 2013 to 2017)

3. The FAM as revised after the review also introduced an “Affordability Cap” under FAM, so that any fare increase rate to be implemented, as per the formula outcome, will not be higher than the change in Median Monthly Household Income (“MMHI”) during the corresponding period.

Overall Fare Adjustment Rate for 2016

4. The Census and Statistics Department (“C&SD”) announced on 21 January 2016 that the year-on-year increase of the CCPI for December 2015 over December 2014 is 2.5%, which was further adjusted to 2.4% on 29 April 2016. On 29 March 2016, C&SD published the year-on-year increase of the

Nominal Wage Index (Transportation Section) for December 2015 over December 2014 which is 4.1%.

5. Applying the formula as set out in paragraph 2 above, the Overall Fare Adjustment Rate for 2016 is +2.65%. Detailed calculation is as follows:

Year-on-year % change in CCPI for December 2015	Year-on-year % change in Nominal Wage Index (Transportation Section) for December 2015	Productivity Factor value (from 2013 to 2017)	Overall Fare Adjustment Rate for 2016
2.4%	4.1%	0.6%	
$(0.5 \times 2.4\%) + (0.5 \times 4.1\%) - 0.6\% = +2.65\%$			

6. As the year-on-year change in MMHI for the fourth quarter of 2015 is +3.33% and it is higher than the formula outcome of +2.65%. Under the “Affordability Cap” mechanism (see paragraph 3 above), the Overall Fare Adjustment Rate for MTR fares in 2016 remains to be +2.65%, without the need to be adjusted downwards.

7. The Overall Fare Adjustment Rate is the figure to which the weighted average adjustment of all individual Controlled Fares combined must equal.

8. FAM is applicable to all Controlled Fares including:

- (a) Adult, Elderly, Student and Child fares for one way journeys on all MTR lines, excluding the Airport Express (but applicable to Airport Workers’ fares);
- (b) East Rail Line First Class Premium fares; and
- (c) all Light Rail and MTR Bus fares.

9. Having regard to the design of the existing fare collection system, the following guiding principles have been applied by the MTRCL in calculating individual Controlled Fares:

- (a) adjustments to Octopus fares are in units of 10 cents; and
- (b) adjustments to Single Journey Ticket fares are in units of 50 cents.

10. The MTRCL has completed the required administrative procedures and submitted the independent experts' certificates to the Government to certify compliance of the calculation of fare adjustments with the FAM requirements. Key information regarding the certification is set out in Annex 1.

11. The new MTR fares will take effect from 26 June 2016 (Sunday). New fare charts are at Annex 2. They will also be made available to the public at MTR stations and on MTRCL's website (www.mtr.com.hk).

12. As a result of the fare adjustment, 78% of the fares will have an increase of 30 cents or less, among which, 4% will remain unchanged and 58% of the trips will be adjusted upwards by 10 or 20 cents. 9% of the fares will see a 40 cent increase, 8% will see a 50 cent increase while 5% (all are fares of non-domestic trips) will go up by more than 50 cents.

2016 Fare Promotions and Continuous Railway Service Enhancement

“10% Same-Day Second-Trip Discount” promotion

13. The FAM as revised in 2013 after the review introduced the “Profit Sharing Mechanism” and “Service Performance Arrangement”. In 2016, the MTRCL will offer fare concessions of \$175 million from the “Profit Sharing Mechanism” and \$11 million from the “Service Performance Arrangement” to passengers. These fare concessions will be provided via a “10% Same-Day Second-Trip Discount” promotion which will last for over 4 months from 26 June 2016 to 31 October 2016. Details of the “10% Same-Day Second-Trip Discount” promotion are at Annex 3.

“MTR City Saver”

14. “MTR City Saver”, which was introduced by the MTRCL in 2013, will continue to be offered this year. This fare promotion scheme has been well received by frequent medium- to long-distance passengers commuting within the urban area, benefitting about 80 000 passengers per month. Holders of “MTR City Saver” tickets are entitled to 40 rides within 30 days from the day of first use among 57 designated stations in the urban area. The “MTR City Saver” will be extended for one year to 30 June 2017 with its price adjusted to \$425. Details are set out in Annex 4.

“Monthly Pass Extras”

15. The MTRCL introduced the “Monthly Pass Extras” in 2013 and currently over 120 000 passengers benefit from this ticket scheme per month. On top of the original unlimited rides among specified stations within the month purchased, “Monthly Pass Extras” also offer a 25% discount for connecting domestic journeys beyond the specified stations. The scheme will be extended for one year to 30 June 2017 and prices of various “Monthly Pass Extras” will be adjusted upwards by \$10 to \$15. Details are set out in Annex 8.

MTR Shops Cash Coupon

16. As a bonus for monthly ticket scheme users, passengers will receive a \$50 MTR Shops Cash Coupon for each purchase of any July or August “Monthly Pass Extra” in 2016 or “MTR City Saver” during these two months.

“Designated Saturday Offer”

17. MTRCL will launch the “Designated Saturday Offer” fare concession scheme to bring savings to various passenger groups travelling on the MTR over the weekend. The discount will be offered on the first Saturday in each month between November 2016 and March 2017. The five designated Saturdays are 5 November 2016, 3 December 2016, 7 January 2017, 4 February 2017 and 4 March 2017. On these five designated Saturdays, Adult Octopus holders will enjoy Child concessionary fares for MTR journeys while passengers who already enjoy Octopus concessionary fares can travel on the MTR for just \$1 per trip (except the Airport Express, East Rail Line First Class and cross-boundary service).

\$2 Discount for All Domestic MTR Fare Savers

18. There are currently 32 MTR fare savers installed across Hong Kong and by waving Adult Octopus over the machines, passengers can enjoy a \$1 or \$2 fare discount when entering designated MTR stations. This promotion has been popular among passengers and the MTRCL will upgrade all (a total of 15) \$1 discount fare savers to \$2 on 1 July 2016 to bring more fare savings to customers. Details of the domestic fare savers are at Annex 5.

“Early Bird Discount Promotion”

19. To address the relatively high train loading situation during the morning peak period, the MTRCL launched an “Early Bird Discount Promotion” Trial Programme in 2014 to encourage passengers to use MTR outside the morning peak period. Under the programme, commuters holding

Adult Octopus can enjoy a 25% fare discount when they exit from any of the 29 core urban stations between 7:15 a.m. and 8:15 a.m. from Mondays to Fridays (except Public Holidays). The programme has benefited an average of around 130 000 passenger trips daily, successfully shifting about 3% of the total patronage (i.e. around 8 200 passenger trips) during peak period to set off earlier in order to enjoy the concessions. The effectiveness of the programme is comparable to those overseas. MTRCL will extend the “Early Bird Discount Promotion” Programme for one year to 31 May 2017. Details are set out in Annex 6.

20. The MTRCL also launched a joint trial scheme with Kowloon Motor Bus Co. (1933) (“KMB”) in 2014 under which holders of designated MTR “Monthly Pass Extras” travelling on specified trips of selected KMB morning bus routes that run parallel to the MTR East Rail Line and West Rail Line on Mondays to Fridays (except Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays) do not need to pay extra fares. Details are at Annex 7. While the scheme aims at easing the demand for train services on the busier sections of the railway network during the morning peak period, it also offers “Monthly Pass Extra” users an alternative choice. The MTRCL and KMB have decided to extend the scheme for one year to 31 May 2017.

21. It is estimated that the abovementioned fare promotions (except “Monthly Pass Extras”) for the next 12 months will bring fare savings of approximately over \$500 million to passengers.

22. In addition, the MTRCL will continue to offer a wide range of on-going fare concessions and promotional schemes to benefit different sectors of the community when using the railway including the elderly, children, eligible students and persons with disabilities. These fare promotions are estimated to bring additional fare savings of \$2.4 billion per year to passengers. Details of the on-going fare concessions together with other promotions are set out in Annex 8.

Measures for Continuous Railway Service Enhancement

23. The MTRCL is committed to providing safe, reliable and comfortable journeys to passengers and making continuous improvement in railway service. Apart from the major asset replacement projects like the purchase of 93 new trains, upgrading the signalling systems for 7 railway lines and replacement of 160 chillers, the MTRCL seeks to continuously make travelling on the MTR easier and more comfortable. In this connection, the MTRCL will launch a number of improvement projects related to station facilities and customer communication, such as:

- (a) installation of additional wide gates at 13 MTR stations;
- (b) installation of additional ventilation fans at 31 MTR stations;
- (c) widening of 4 Light Rail platforms and replacement of wooden benches on all Light Rail platforms; and
- (d) replacement of Passenger Information Display System in the Light Rail network.

24. MTRCL has set aside about \$140 million for measures for enhancing railway service including the abovementioned projects.

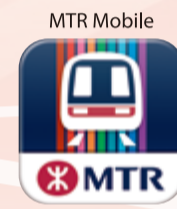

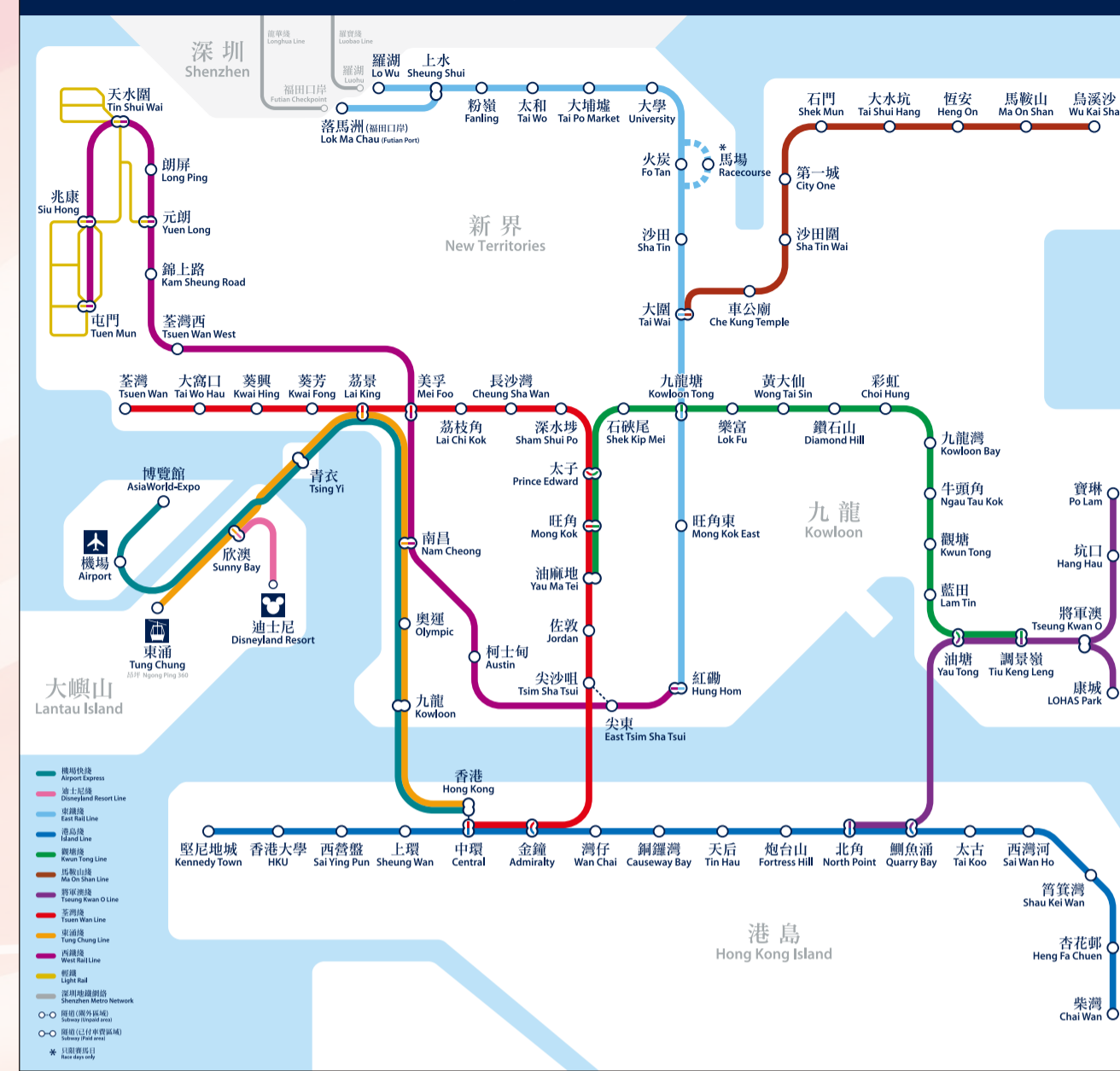

Using Octopus on the MTR

Apart from Single Journey Tickets, using an Octopus to ride on the MTR is both convenient and cost-saving. Adult, Child or Elder Octopus are available for sale at any Customer Service Centre. Passengers can add-value to an Octopus by using the Add-Value Machine or by going to the Customer Service Centre in any station.

The price of an Octopus includes a HK\$50 refundable deposit. If the remaining value stored on an Octopus is less than the amount of the fare being paid, a negative value of up to HK\$35 is permitted to enable the cardholder to complete the journey. Eligible full-time students studying in Hong Kong may apply for a Personalised Octopus with "Student Status" to enjoy concessionary fares on the MTR network. Eligible persons with disabilities may also apply for a Personalised Octopus with "Persons with Disabilities Status" to enjoy concessionary fares on the MTR network. First Class Service on East Rail Line

Passengers have the option of paying a premium to enjoy the East Rail Line's First Class Service. The First Class Premium is equivalent to the normal Standard Class Fare for the same East Rail Line journey.

Using Octopus to Enjoy First Class Service

Before entering the First Class compartment, passengers must validate their Octopus for First Class by swiping their Octopus over a First Class Processor. The processors are located on the platforms of the East Rail Line or beside the gangway doors of the First Class compartment. There will be a green light and "beep" sound once an Octopus has been validated.

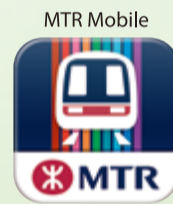

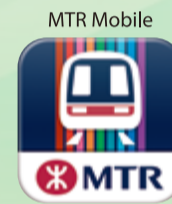

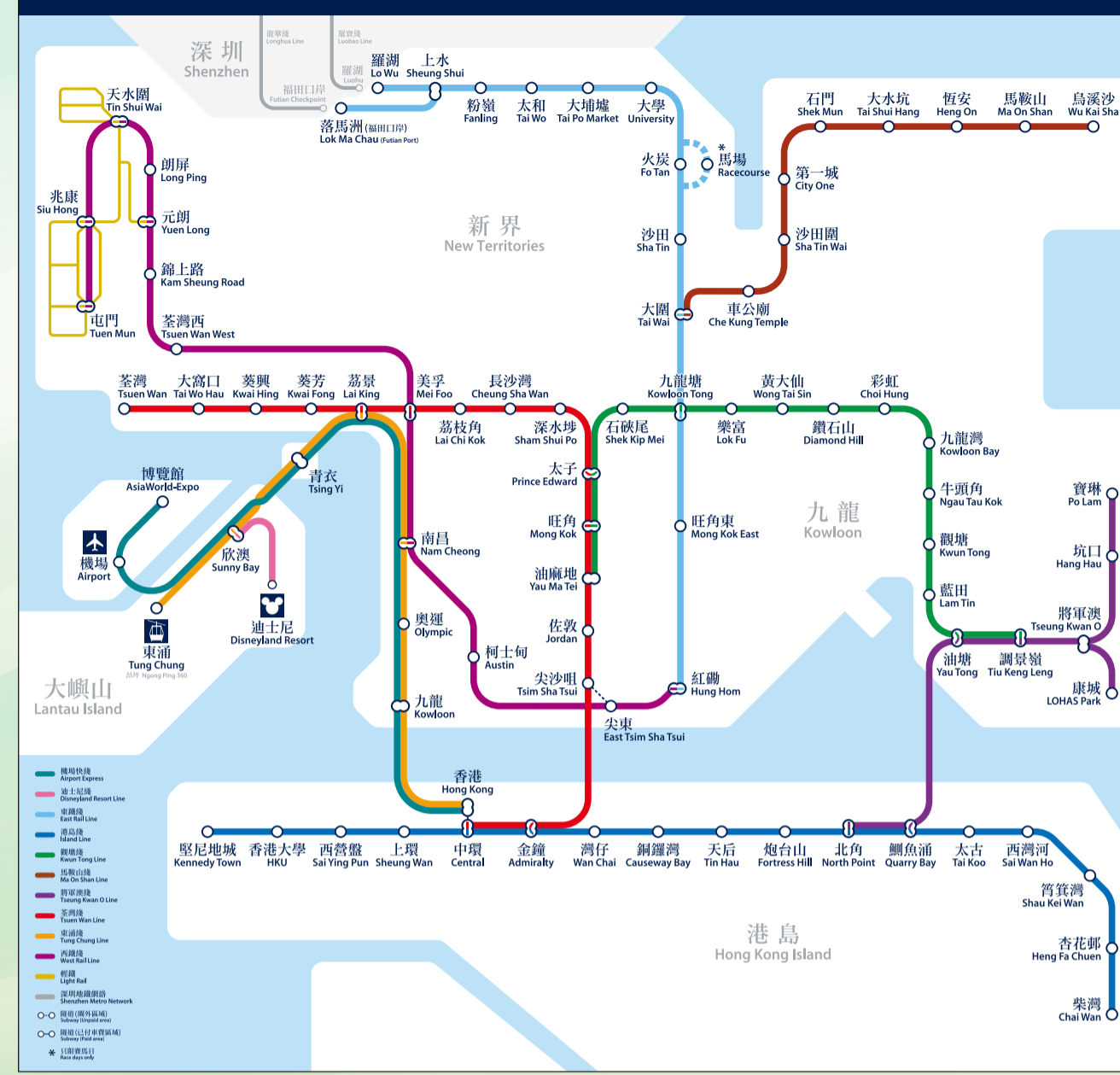

使用單程票乘搭港鐵

除八達通外，乘客亦可選擇使用單程票乘搭港鐵。單程票可於購票當日使用一次前往預先選定之車站，車費按車程距離釐定。

尖沙咀站及尖東站為兩個獨立車站，分別設有出入閘機。使用單程票的乘客如欲經尖沙咀或尖東站乘搭另一條港鐵綫，須先購買一張前往該站的車票，車票於該站出閘時會被閘機收回，乘客須再另購一張車票，繼續餘下車程，但兩程的合計車費會高於使用一張單程票於其他轉綫車站如九龍塘、美孚或南昌站轉綫往同一目的地。



單程票種類

港鐵單程票分成人及特惠兩種，乘客可於任何港鐵站內的售票機購買。

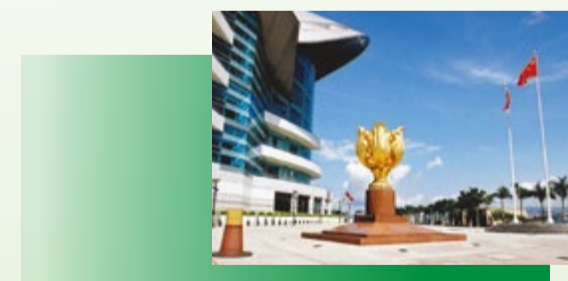

Using Single Journey Tickets on the MTR

Apart from Octopus, passengers may use Single Journey Tickets to travel on the MTR. A Single Journey Ticket entitles the passenger to one ride to a pre-selected destination on the day of purchase. The fare is based on the distance travelled.

Tsim Sha Tsui and East Tsim Sha Tsui are however, two separate stations and have separate entry and exit ticket gates. Passengers using Single Journey Tickets and changing Lines here will need to purchase two separate tickets. The first ticket is collected upon exit at the first station while another ticket should be bought at the second station for the next leg of the journey.

Passengers may choose a different route to their destination station by interchanging at Kowloon Tong, Mei Foo or Nam Cheong stations where only one Single Journey Ticket is required. Fares for journeys using two Single Journey Tickets are higher than those using only one Single Journey Ticket.

Single Journey Ticket Types

There are two types of Single Journey Tickets – Adult and Concessionary. Passengers can purchase them from Ticket Issuing Machines in all MTR stations.

Concessionary Tickets are available for children aged 3 to 11 and senior citizens aged 65 or above. Students aged 12 and above travelling with Single Journey Tickets are required to pay full adult fare.

First Class Service is available on the East Rail Line. Passengers may enjoy the First Class Service by paying a premium equivalent to the Standard Class Fare of the East Rail Line journey. First Class Single Journey Tickets can be purchased from Ticket Issuing Machines in East Rail Line stations or from Customer Service Centre in any MTR station.

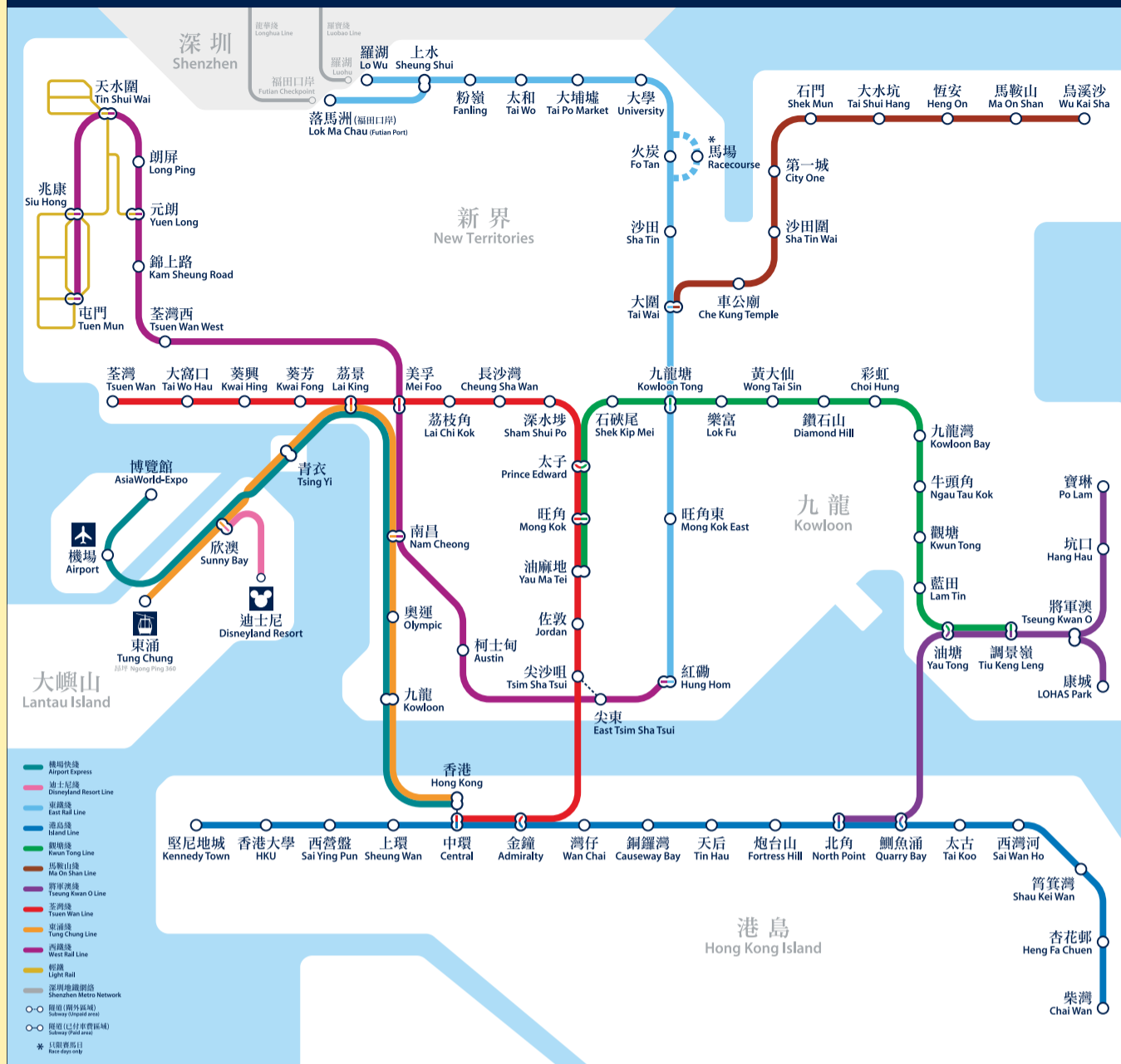

- Remarks
1. First Class Premium: On top of the above fare, the premium payable by passengers travelling in the First Class compartment on East Rail Line trains is equivalent to the Single Journey Ticket fare for the same East Rail Line journey.
2. Concessory Single Journey Ticket fares are only applicable for children aged 3 to 11 and senior citizens aged 65 and above.
3. Except senior citizens and eligible persons with disabilities, a passenger who exits the gate of a station more than 20 minutes after passing through an entry gate of the same station is liable to pay an additional fare. Please refer to the "Conditions of Issue of Tickets" for further details.
4. A passenger who travels without a valid ticket is liable to pay a surcharge. Please refer to the "Conditions of Issue of Tickets" for further details.

Public Transport Fare Concession Scheme for the Elderly and Eligible Persons with Disabilities

With the implementation of the Government's "Public Transport Fare Concession Scheme for the Elderly and Eligible Persons with Disabilities", senior citizens using Elder Octopus or Personalised Octopus and eligible persons with disabilities using Personalised Octopus with "Persons with Disabilities Status" can enjoy \$2 per journey (if the original fare for the journey is lower than \$2, only the original fare will be charged) for MTR domestic services* on all days.

How to Apply for Personalised Octopus with "Persons with Disabilities Status"

Newly approved recipients of Disability Allowance or the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance Scheme with 100% disabilities will receive a referral letter and an application form from Social Welfare Department. Applicants for Personalised Octopus with "Persons with Disabilities Status" please refer to the application form for further details.

Eligible applicants who did not receive the referral letter with the MTR application form may obtain the form from MTR Customer Service Centres (except for Airport Express, Lo Wu, Lok Ma Chau, Racecourse, Disneyland Resort and Sunny Bay stations).

Persons with disabilities using Single Journey Tickets for travel are required to buy adult tickets at full fares.

Report Loss of Personalised Octopus with "Persons with Disabilities Status"

If your card is lost or stolen, it must immediately be reported to Lost Octopus Reporting Hotline 2266 2266. You may apply for the issuance of a replacement Octopus.

If you want to continue enjoying concessionary fares while waiting for the replacement Octopus to be issued, you may go in person to the MTR Customer Service Centres (except for Airport Express) to obtain a Temporary Proof of "Persons with Disabilities Status" and purchase a Temporary Octopus with "Persons with Disabilities Status". The Temporary Proof of "Persons with Disabilities Status" must be carried when using the Temporary Octopus until the replacement of Personalised Octopus with "Persons with Disabilities Status" is issued. The Temporary Octopus with "Persons with Disabilities Status" can be refunded at any MTR Customer Service Centres (except for Airport Express).

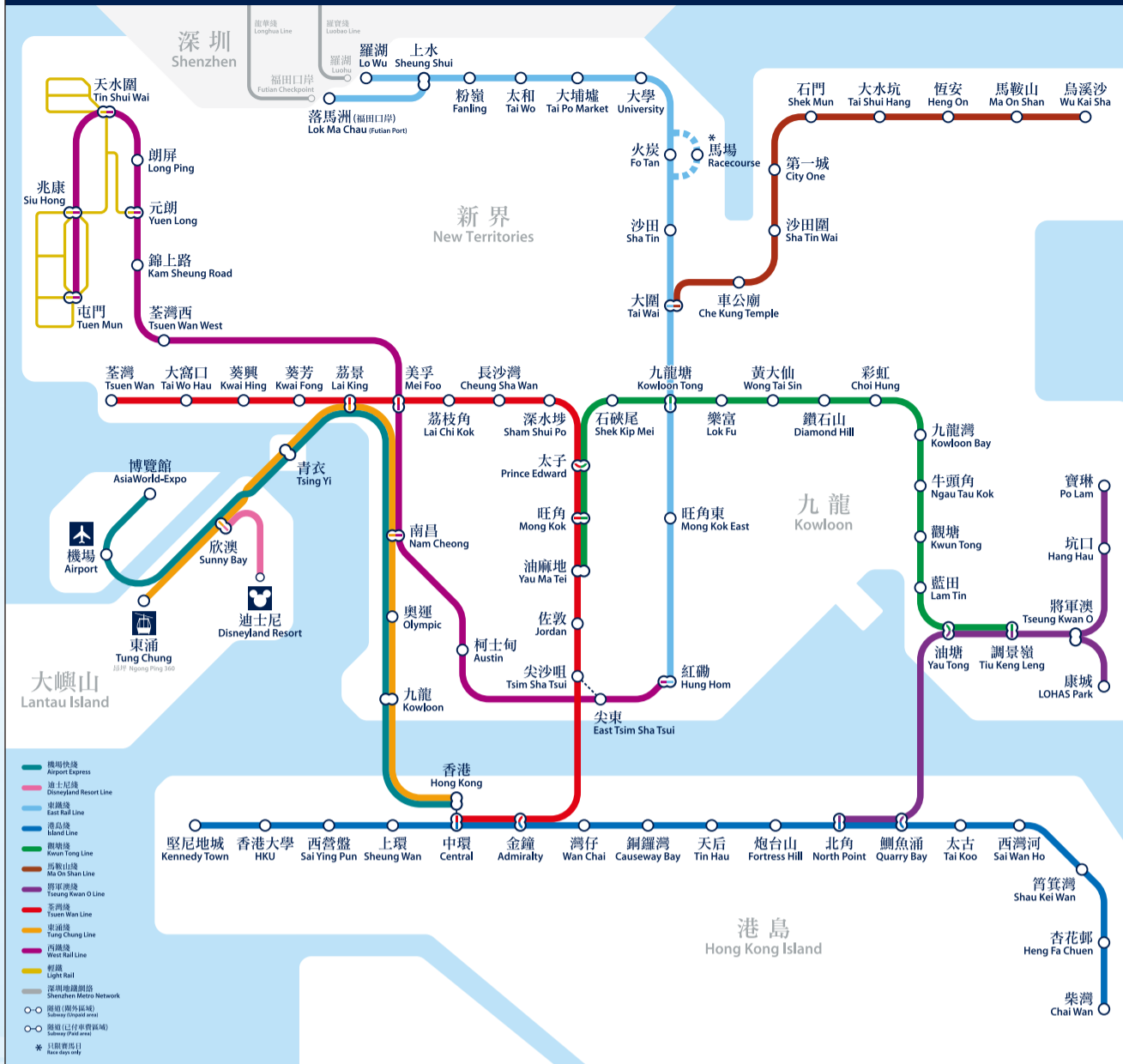

- 頭等額外費：**使用長者八達通或個人八達通之長者，及使用已加註「殘疾人士身分」的合資格殘疾人士享用東鐵綫頭等車廂服務，除需支付 \$2 車費外，另須支付頭等額外費，額外費相等於該程東鐵綫車程的原有車費。如持有人使用之八達通有登記乘坐頭等的記錄，但八達通內所顯示的進入及離開的車站均不屬於東鐵綫的車站，其須支付頭等額外費則等於東鐵綫車程的相對最低額八達通車費。

Remarks

- The "Public Transport Fare Concession Scheme for the Elderly and Eligible Persons with Disabilities" includes MTR, Light Rail, MTR Bus (North West New Territories) and MTR Feeder Bus. However, Airport Express, journeys to and from Lo Wu and Lok Ma Chau stations and First Class Service of East Rail Line are not covered under the Scheme.
- First Class Premium:** Senior citizens using Elder Octopus or Personalised Octopus and eligible persons with disabilities using Personalised Octopus with "Persons with Disabilities Status" may enjoy the First Class Service of East Rail Line by paying the \$2 fare and a First Class premium. The premium is equivalent to the original Octopus fare for the same East Rail Line Journey. They are required to pay a premium that is equivalent to the minimum Octopus fare for an East Rail Line journey if such passengers use the Octopus which have an authorization code for the First Class travel but the entry and exit station records on the Octopus are not East Rail Line stations.
- Interchange between Tsim Sha Tsui and East Tsim Sha Tsui stations:** Senior citizens using Elder Octopus or Personalised Octopus and eligible persons with disabilities using Personalised Octopus with "Persons with Disabilities Status" who interchange between Tsim Sha Tsui and East Tsim Sha Tsui stations within 30 minutes will be considered as having taken one journey. The full fare for the first sector travelled before the interchange will be deducted when exiting the gate. After the interchange, no fare will be deducted upon exit at the final destination. Passengers are reminded not to use the same Octopus on other transport (including Light Rail, MTR Bus and MTR Feeder Bus) or make more than 9 non-transport related transactions during the 30-minute interchange interval. Otherwise, full fares for two separate journeys will be charged. However, any same station entry and exit trips at these two stations, or any trips to or from Lo Wu / Lok Ma Chau interchanging between Tsim Sha Tsui and East Tsim Sha Tsui stations will be treated as two separate journeys, and not form a part of an interchange journey, with separate fares charged.
- A passenger who travels without a valid ticket is liable to pay a surcharge. Please refer to the "Conditions of Issue of Tickets" for further details.

乘搭輕鐵

輕鐵採用開放式月台，乘客可使用八達通或單程票乘車。

使用八達通

- 使用八達通的乘客必須於登車車站之「入站收費器」上拍卡確認入站，待綠燈亮起，屏幕上顯示「請上車」，並發出成功確認的聲響，方可前往乘車。車程不能超過120分鐘。
- 確認入站時，系統會按八達通票種先扣除輕鐵最高車費。確認出站時，系統會將入站時多付的車費退回八達通內。
- 下車時，乘客必須在「出站收費器」上拍卡確認完成車程，否則將會收取輕鐵的最高車費。
- 乘客於同一車站確認入站及出站而沒有乘搭輕鐵，須付最低車費；若原站出站時間為確認入站後5分鐘內，則豁免車費。

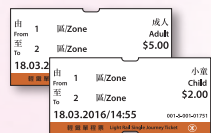

Travelling on the Light Rail

The Light Rail network adopts an open system. Passengers can travel on the Light Rail using their Octopus or Single Journey Tickets.

Using Octopus

- Passengers must validate their entry by touching their Octopus over an "Entry Fare Processor" before proceeding to board the train. With a green light and a 'beep' sound, "Permit to Travel" will appear on the screen upon authorization. The journey must be completed within 120 minutes.
- Maximum fare by Octopus type will be deducted during entry validation. The excess amount collected from entry will be refunded into the Octopus during exit validation.
- When exiting from a Light Rail Stop, users must touch their Octopus over an "Exit Fare Processor" to validate the completion of the journey. Otherwise, a deduction equivalent to the maximum fare will be made.
- Passengers validating their entry and exit at the same stop without travel by Light Rail must pay the minimum fare. However, if the time between the entry validation and exit validation at the same stop is less than 5 minutes, the fare will be waived.
- Passengers, who repeat the Octopus entry validation at the same stop more than 5 minutes after the first entry, are deemed to be travelling by Light Rail a second time. The maximum fare deducted for the first validation will not be refunded.
- If passengers touch their Octopus over the "Entry Fare Processor" instead of the "Exit Fare Processor" after exiting from the train, an amount doubling the maximum fare will be deducted.

Using Single Journey Tickets

- There are two types of Light Rail Single Journey Tickets: Adult and Child/Senior Citizen.
- Each Single Journey Ticket is valid for 120 minutes after purchase, and can be used only for a journey from the stop where the ticket is purchased to another stop in a single direction.
- Tickets are sold at Ticket Issuing Machines, which accept banknotes and coins and provide change where necessary.
- Passengers can also purchase tickets from the Ticket Issuing Machines on the opposite platform and return to the original platform to board the train.

The offer also applies to Elderly Octopus and Eligible Persons with Disabilities Octopus for the equivalent eligible Light Rail journeys of Child Octopus.
- When interchanging from the MTR to the Light Rail, no fare will be deducted for the Light Rail journey. If passengers interchange from the Light Rail to the MTR, they must pay the Light Rail fare first, and the net fare will be deducted upon completion of the MTR journey. The net fare is equivalent to the MTR fare after deducting the Light Rail fare. Should the MTR fare be less than the Light Rail fare, the excess amount will be refunded at the exit gate of the MTR except for same MTR station entry and exit.
- The time limit for any interchange is 30 minutes from the exit validation to the entry validation.
- Interchange discount also apply to transfers between Light Rail and MTR Bus; transfer from Light Rail / MTR Bus to MTR to Light Rail / MTR Bus, and from MTR Bus to Light Rail to MTR Bus. The whole journey must be completed within 120 minutes for the discount to apply. Interchange discount is not applicable with entry and exit validation at the same Light Rail stop. For details of interchange with MTR Bus, please refer to MTR Bus and Feeder Bus Guide.
- When travelling on the Light Rail, passengers must validate their entry and exit at the stop according to normal practice. Failure to do so will be considered as travelling without tickets and the passenger will be subject to a surcharge.
- The same Octopus (with a positive remaining value) must be used in order to benefit from the free interchange.

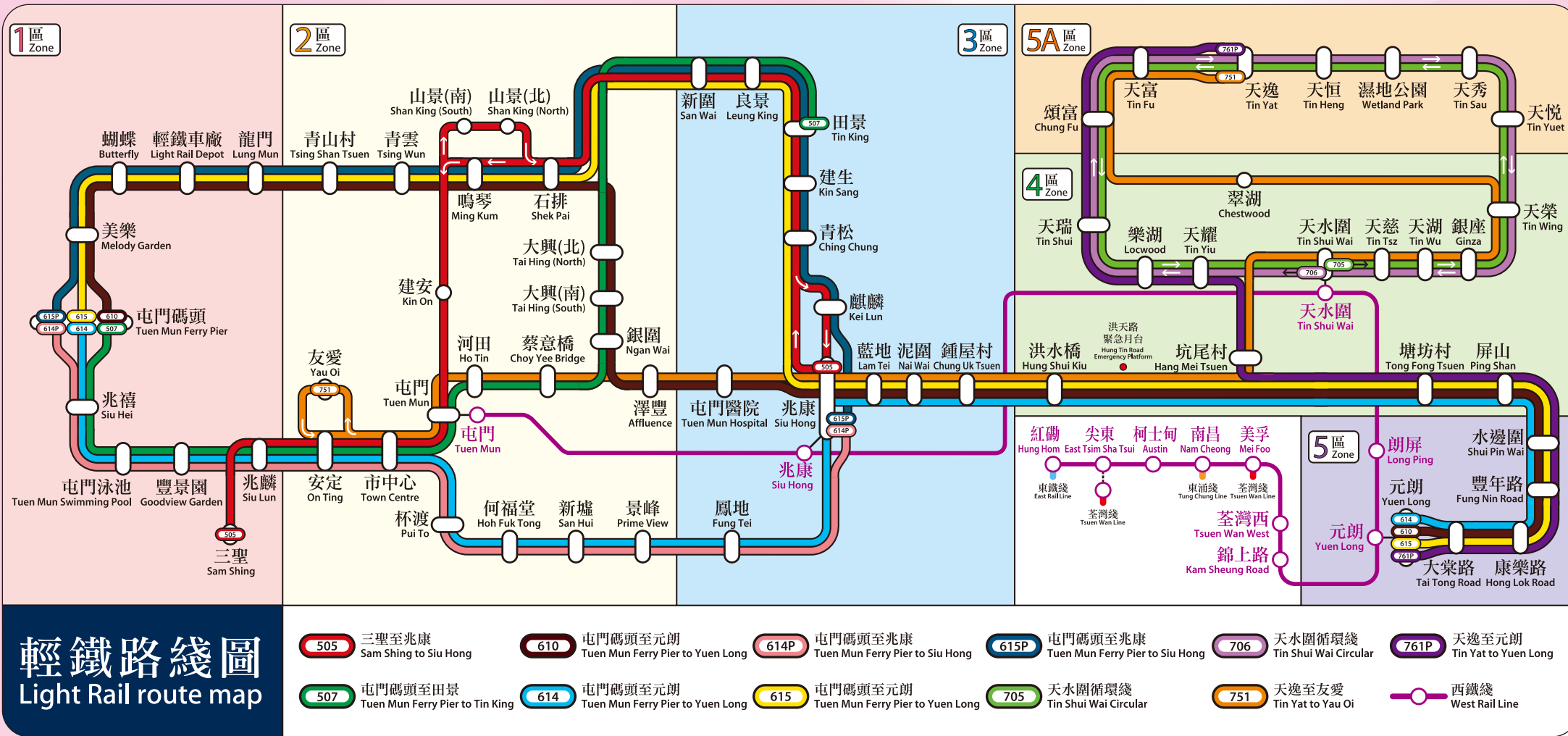

“10% Same-Day Second-Trip Discount” Promotion in 2016

The MTRCL will offer passengers the “10% Same-Day Second-Trip Discount” promotion for over 4 months from 26 June to 31 October 2016. The promotion will bring passengers fare savings of \$186 million. Details are set out below:

(i) “Profit Sharing Mechanism”

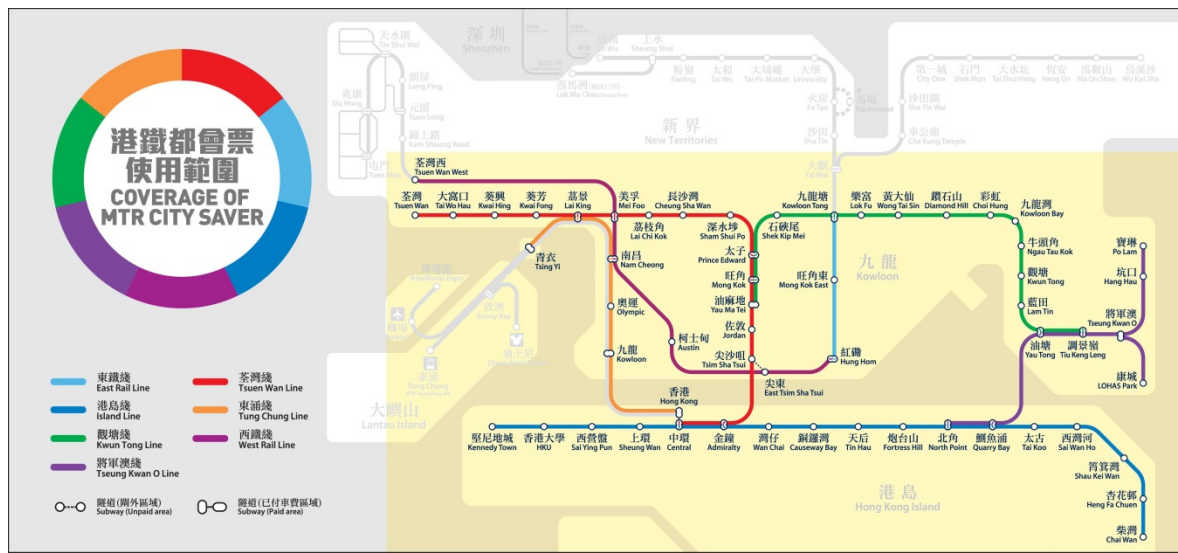
Since 2013, the MTRCL has been sharing its yearly underlying business profit with passengers by way of the “10% Same-Day Second-Trip Discount” promotion. For this purpose, a pre-determined tiered table is used to decide the amount to be shared with passengers under different profit levels with the amount put into a fare concession account. According to the tiered table, an amount of \$175 million will be shared with passengers in 2016 through the “10% Same-Day Second-Trip Discount” promotion.

(ii) “Service Performance Arrangement”

According to the outcome of the FAM review in 2013, a “Service Performance Arrangement” has been introduced whereby an amount, ranging from \$1 million to \$15 million, will be set aside for each serious service disruption of 31 minutes or above which are within the control of the MTRCL. There were 8 such disruptions in 2015 accumulating \$11 million to be offered to passengers through the “10% Same-Day Second-Trip Discount” promotion.

“MTR City Saver”

The MTRCL launched the “MTR City Saver” in June 2014 to benefit frequent medium- to long-distance passengers commuting within the urban area, i.e. essentially the zone not covered by the existing “Monthly Pass Extras”. Holders of “MTR City Saver” tickets are entitled to 40 rides within 30 days from the day of first use between the 57 designated stations in the urban area. The “MTR City Saver” will be extended for one year to 30 June 2017 and its price will be adjusted from originally \$415 to \$425 starting from 1 July 2016. Passengers may enjoy 11% to 25% fare discounts for typical journeys after the 2016 fare adjustment with this promotion.

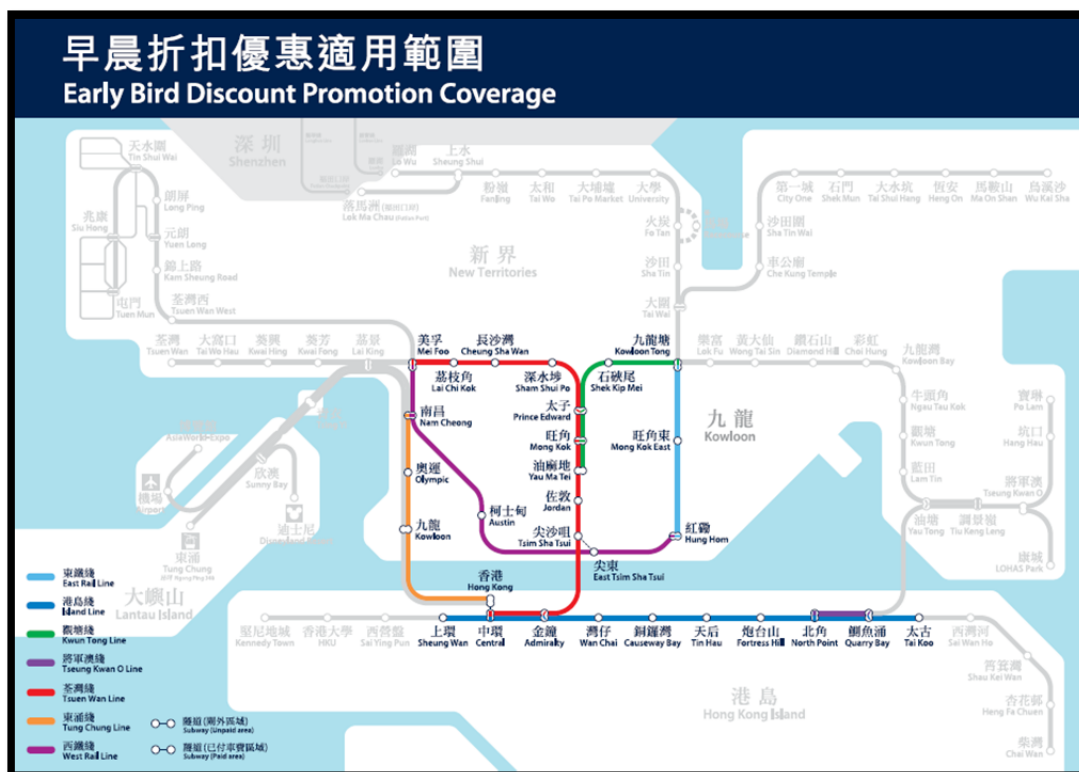

“Early Bird Discount Promotion” Programme

To address the relatively high train loading situation during the morning peak period, the MTRCL launched the “Early Bird Discount Promotion” Trial Programme in 2014. Commuters holding Adult Octopus can enjoy a 25% fare discount when they exit from any of the 29 core urban stations between 7:15 a.m. and 8:15 a.m. from Mondays to Fridays (except Public Holidays). The “Early Bird Discount Promotion” Programme will be extended for one year to 31 May 2017.



Joint MTR and KMB Scheme for “Monthly Pass Extra” Passengers

Holders of designated MTR “Monthly Pass Extras” travelling on specified trips of selected KMB morning bus routes running parallel to the MTR East Rail Line and West Rail Line on Mondays to Fridays (except Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays) do not need to pay extra fares. The scheme will be extended for one year to 31 May 2017. Details are set out below:

Existing Fare Concessions of MTRCL**“Monthly Pass Extras”**

The “Monthly Pass Extras” will continue to be offered. Purchased each month and encoded in Octopus, users are entitled to unlimited rides between the specified stations within the month purchased and enjoy a 25% discount for connecting domestic journeys beyond the specified stations. The new prices of the “Monthly Pass Extras” will take effect from 1 July 2016 and they are set out below:

Day Pass

The Day Pass promotion will be extended for one year to 30 June 2017. The new price of Tuen Mun – Nam Cheong Day Pass will be \$27 (the original price is \$26) starting 1 July 2016.

Under the Public Transport Fare Concession Scheme for the Elderly and Eligible Persons with Disabilities implemented by the Government since 28 June 2012, Elderly and eligible Persons with Disabilities enjoy the concessionary fare of \$2 per trip for MTR domestic service.
