Parental substance abuse and child protection

- 1. How many pregnant women are drug users in Hong Kong? Please provide figures in the past five years.
- 2. How many cases of parental substance abuse have been assessed AND followed up through CCDS (Comprehensive Child Development Service 兒童身心全面發展服務)? What happens to the rest of the cases?
- 3. How many substance abusers have children under their care?
- 4. How many MDCCs (Multi-disciplinary Case Conference on Protection of Child with Suspected Abuse 多專業個案 會議) in the past year has the presence of medical practitioners or psychiatrists/psychologists? How many of them don't?
- 5. If the parents/carers of a child are problem substance abusers, will this case be defined as child abuse? What policies/ system are currently in place to protect children under such circumstances?
- 6. Is the government planning to give a legal definition of child abuse (i.e. making it as a project under the Law Reform Commission of HK)?
- 7. Is the government planning to conduct a full and independent case review on Yeung Chi-wai's case (楊智維案)?
- 8. According to "Guidelines for the Psychosocially Assisted pharmacological Treatment of Opioid Dependence by WHO (世界衛生組織) 2009", when a person's substance abuse poses a risk to others, this consideration can override his/her freedom of choosing whether to participate in treatment. Is the government planning to investigate the possibility of mandatory detoxification for parents and pregnant women?

- 8. Of the children in care and of whose original permanency plan is family reunion, what is the percentage of parents having regular engagement with child, what is the percentage of parents having irregular engagement with children, what is the percentage of parents having no contact with child?
