DEAR HON MEMBERS AND FRIENDS.

I AM HONOURED THAT OUR CHAIRMAN MR. DEREK HUNG HAS ASKED ME TO SAY A FEW WORDS ON THE EMPLOYMENT OF E M'S IN H.K.

SINCE MY TALK IS RESTRICTED TO 3 MINS, I SHALL BE BRIEF AND TRY MY BEST TO REFLECT MY VIEWS ON THIS SUBJECT .

I WAS BORN AND RAISED IN H.K. SO THE TOPIC OF EM'S IN GENERAL IS ONE I AM PASSIONATE ABOUT. IN THOSE COLONIAL DAYS THERE WASN'T A PROBLEM REGARDING E M EMPLOYMENT BECAUSE THE TREND WAS THAT MOST WERE EITHER IN THE BRITISH ARMY OR IN HER MAJESTY PRISONS AS IT WAS CALLED IN THOSE DAYS. THE REST WERE MOSTLY WORKING AS WATCHMAN IN HOTELS AND RESTAURANTS.

AT THE SAME TIME, WE SHOULD NOT FORGET OUR OWN CULTURE AND HERITAGE. WE SHOULD PROUDLY SHARE THIS WITH OTHERS AND MAKE H.K. A BETTER, MORE DIVERSE PLACE TO LIVE IN SO THAT H.K. CAN THRIVE AS A TRUE COSMOPOLITAN CITY.
