### Clause-by-clause examination of the Bill

2. The Bills Committee completed the examination of clauses 1 to 3 of the Bill.

#### Committee stage amendments to the Bill

3. <u>Members</u> in principle agreed that the Administration should propose a Committee stage amendment ("CSA") to the Schedule to exclude specifically the proceedings of the Legislative Council (including the proceedings of its committees, panels and subcommittees) from the application of the Bill. All Members should be informed of the proposed arrangement.

(*Post-meeting note*: Members were informed of the Administration's proposal to move a CSA to the Schedule to the Bill vide LC Paper No. CB(4)1225/16-17 on 13 June 2017.)

4. <u>Members</u> noted the Administration's proposal to move a CSA to clause 8(2) to address members' concerns. <u>Members</u> in general agreed to the direction of the proposed CSA but considered that the requirements could be further revised.

#### Follow-up actions by the Administration

- 5. The Administration was requested to:
  - (a) explain the legal basis for asserting that the expression "rule of law" under clause 10(3) of the Bill could refer to other clauses, such as clause 8(2), of the same Bill; and
  - (b) re-consider how to address members' concerns on clause 8(2) of the Bill.

(*Post-meeting note*: The Administration's written response was issued to members vide LC Paper Nos. CB(4)1248/16-17(01) and CB(4)1248/16-17(03) on 16 June 2017.)

6. <u>Members</u> agreed that the next two meetings of the Bills Committee would be scheduled for 13 June 2017 at 4:30 pm and 19 June 2017 at 8:30 am to continue the clause-by-clause examination of the Bill.
