#### I. Meeting with the Administration

(LC Paper Nos. CB(2)408/17-18(01), CB(2)526/17-18(01) & (02), CB(2)686/17-18(01) and CB(2)692/17-18(01))

<u>The Bills Committee</u> deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

2. <u>The Bills Committee</u> received the Administration's briefing on its response to issues raised at the meeting on 21 November 2017 (LC Paper Nos. CB(2)408/17-18(01) & CB(2)526/17-18(01)).

(At 9:10 am, a voting bell was rung to notify members of the Public Works Subcommittee ("PWSC") that voting would take place at the PWSC meeting being held concurrently in Conference Room 1. The Chairman initially ordered that the Bills Committee meeting be suspended for 20 minutes to allow members to participate in the voting at the meeting of PWSC held in Conference Room 1. Prof Joseph LEE however suggested continuing the Bills Committee's discussion. The Chairman thus decided to continue the meeting.)

#### Committee stage amendments ("CSAs") to the Bill

3. The Administration took members through the finalized version of its proposed CSAs to the Dutiable Commodities (Amendment) Bill 2017 ("the Bill"), as set out in Annex B to LC Paper No. CB(2)526/17-18(01). Members raised no objection to CSAs to be moved by the Administration.

#### <u>Legislative timetable</u>

4. The Chairman concluded that the Bills Committee had completed the scrutiny of the Bill. Members agreed that the Chairman would report the deliberations of the Bills Committee to the House Committee on 26 January 2018, supporting the resumption of the Second Reading debate on the Bill. Members noted that the Administration would later advise on the proposed date for resumption of the Second Reading debate on the Bill. The Secretariat would inform members of the legislative timetable in due course.

(*Post-meeting note*: Members were informed vide LC Paper No. CB(2)745/17-18 on 22 January 2018 that the Administration would give notice for resumption of the Second Reading debate on the Bill at the Council meeting of 7 February 2018.)
