

**Bills Committee on United Nations (Anti-Terrorism Measures)  
(Amendment) Bill 2017**

**List of follow-up actions arising from the discussion  
at the meeting on 10 October 2017**

The Administration was requested to:

- (a) provide a consolidated response to the issues raised by attending deputations/individuals as well as those raised in the written submissions to the Bills Committee;
- (b) provide information on whether and how the United Nations Security Council Resolution 2178 was implemented by other jurisdictions;
- (c) explain whether the attending of a religious lecture or retreat would constitute the attending of a terrorist training;
- (d) provide a response on whether Administration would, in relation to persons designated as terrorist by the Central People's Government, make an application to court under section 5 of the United Nations (Anti-Terrorism Measures) Ordinance (Cap. 575) for designating such persons as terrorist; and
- (e) provide information on the court procedures for considering such an application by the Administration, including whether relevant parties would be allowed to join in the proceedings.
