

Bank of Communications (Hong Kong) Limited (Merger) Bill
Debate and voting arrangements

Object of the Bill : To provide for the vesting in Bank of Communications (Hong Kong) Limited of the undertakings of the Hong Kong branch of Bank of Communications Co., Ltd. and for other related purposes.

First debate	: Clauses with no amendment – Clauses 1, 3 to 18
Voting	: To vote on the above clauses standing part of the Bill together
Second debate	: Clause with amendments proposed by Hon CHAN Chun-ying – Clause 2
Joint debate on the original clause and the amendments.	
Clause 2	
- As the Insurance Companies Ordinance (Cap. 41) has been renamed as Insurance Ordinance from 26 June 2017, the amendments seek to amend Clause 2(1) of the Bill to change “Insurance Companies Ordinance” referred to in the definitions of “ <i>corporate banking business</i> ”, “ <i>private banking business</i> ” and “ <i>retail banking business</i> ” to “Insurance Ordinance”.	
Voting	: To vote on the above amendments, and then the original clause or the clause as amended standing part of the Bill
