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## Action

### **I Election of Chairman**

#### Election of Chairman

Dr KWOK Ka-ki, the Deputy Chairman, presided over the election of the Chairman of the Subcommittee and invited nominations for the chairmanship.

2. Dr KWOK Ka-ki was nominated by Dr Fernando CHEUNG and the nomination was seconded by Mr Kenneth LEUNG. Dr KWOK Ka-ki accepted the nomination. As Dr KWOK Ka-ki was nominated for the office, Mr LEUNG Yiu-chung, the member present who had the highest precedence among members not nominated, preside over the election. Mr LEUNG Yiu-chung called for other nominations. There being no other nomination, Mr LEUNG Yiu-chung declared that Dr KWOK Ka-ki was elected the Chairman of the Subcommittee.

3. Members agreed that there was no need to elect a Deputy Chairman.

001002 – 001316	Chairman Ms Claudia MO	<p>Ms MO was of the view that the Subcommittee should urge the Administration to develop clear and comprehensive policies on bazaars and hawking trade, to designate a centralized authority for handling bazaar proposals, and to brief members on the new-term Government's views on the policy on bazaars soonest possible after the Policy Address 2017.</p>

001317 – 001425	Chairman Dr Fernando CHEUNG	Dr CHEUNG suggested the Subcommittee to include recommendations in its report to be submitted to the House Committee ("HC"), including those suggested by community groups, and seek HC's support to allocate a debate slot at a Council meeting for the Council to take note of the Subcommittee's report.	
001426 – 001710	Chairman Dr CHIANG Lai-wan	Dr CHIANG was of the view that the Administration should establish a consultative platform under the Food and Health Bureau (with representatives from departments concerned) to oversee implementation of and formulate the policy on bazaars, in particular to promote the establishment of bazaars with special features, e.g. for promoting cultural creativity, for interested young people to sell their handicrafts, etc.	
001711 – 002141	Chairman Mr SHIU Ka-chun Mr KWONG Chun-yu	Mr SHIU and Mr KWONG expressed dissatisfaction that the Administration did not arrange any public officers to attend the meeting.  Mr SHIU suggested the Subcommittee to hold a public hearing on issues relating to cooked food bazaars and Lunar New Year bazaars, as well as consider conducting an overseas duty visit.	
002142 – 002412	Chairman Mr LEUNG Yiu-chung	Mr LEUNG suggested that –  (a) the Subcommittee should invite interested parties to give views on the new-term Government's policy on bazaars, and the policies and issues relating to festive bazaars, such as Lunar New Year bazaars;  (b) the Subcommittee should arrange a meeting for concluding its work; and  (c) the Administration should provide papers on the new-term Government's policy on bazaars and hawking trade (including street tradesmen with characteristics reminiscent of local culture and heritage).

002413 – 002701	Chairman Mr WONG Ting-kwong	Mr WONG concurred that the Administration should set up a designated department to promote the long-term development of bazaars. He remarked that issues relating to bazaars could be monitored and followed up by relevant Panel(s) after the Subcommittee had completed its work.	
002702 – 003708	Chairman Dr CHIANG Lai-wan Mr SHIU Ka-chun	<p>The Chairman concluded that the Subcommittee would hold at least four meetings in October and November 2017 to discuss the following issues so that the Subcommittee would complete its work before 5 December 2017 –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) public hearing on policies and issues relating to Lunar New Year bazaars and cooked food bazaars;</li> <li>(b) new-term Government's views on the policy on bazaars;</li> <li>(c) public hearing on the new-term Government's policy on bazaars; and</li> <li>(d) concluding the work of the Subcommittee, including the recommendations to be included in its report to HC.</li> </ul> <p>Dr CHIANG suggested inviting youth organizations to give views at the public hearing on the new-term Government's policy on bazaars. As regards the proposal of conducting an overseas duty visit on bazaars, Dr CHIANG opined that it would be more appropriate for the Panel on Food Safety and Environmental Hygiene to conduct the duty visit. Members agreed.</p> <p>Mr SHIU suggested the Subcommittee to discuss the Government's review on the operation of Tin Sau Bazaar and the way forward of the Bazaar. Members agreed.</p>
