Follow-up actions arising from the meeting on 20 December 2016

The Administration is requested to provide information on:

- (a) Details of the application procedures for setting up bazaars in various districts, and factors and criteria adopted by the Administration in vetting the applications;
- (b) Whether applications for setting up bazaars or Poon Choi feasts involving heating activities using "naked flame" (男火) are subject to different application procedures; details on the types of licences required, the consultation processes, and factors and criteria adopted by the Administration in vetting such applications;
- (c) The Administration's response to Subcommittee members' suggestion of establishing a one-stop platform to facilitate the public in making applications for setting up bazaars;
- (d) A list of bazaars applications submitted to the 18 District Councils in the past three years and their results of applications, including whether the applications involved heating activities using naked flame;
- (e) A list of potential sites in each of the 18 districts that may be considered for setting up bazaars, and the criteria adopted by the Administration in considering whether a site is suitable for establishing a bazaar;
- (f) The Government's policy on community kitchens;
- (g) The Administration's response to the three motions passed at the meeting; and
- (h) The Administration's response to the views raised by deputations at the meeting and concerns in their submissions.
