1. Definition of bazaar and the roles of various departments under the existing policy on bazaars as well as the provision of land for relevant use

- The definition of bazaar and the differences between bazaar, market and hawker area

February 2017

- Existing policies in relation to bazaars, and the roles of relevant government bureaux and departments in implementing the policies (including the Food and Health Bureau, Commerce and Economic Development (Home Bureau. Home **Affairs** Bureau **Affairs** Department, Leisure and Cultural Services Department), Labour and Welfare Bureau. Development Bureau (Lands Department, Highways Department))
