Follow-up actions arising from the meeting on 24 October 2017

- 1. The Administration is requested to provide before the next Subcommittee meeting scheduled for 7 November 2017, information on :
 - (a) a copy of the new guidelines developed by the Administration to facilitate the public in making applications for setting up bazaars; and
 - (b) details and implementation timetable regarding the initiative to "select suitable non-profit-making organization to operate a weekend flea market on the Tourism Node site at the former airport runway tip" as announced in the Policy Agenda 2017 to be taken forward by the Development Bureau.
- 2. The Administration is requested to provide information on :
 - (c) a list of open spaces at the rooftop of public markets that are (i) managed by the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department; (ii) used by other departments for designated purposes (e.g. leisure venues managed by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department) and (iii) used for installing facilities (e.g. electrical and mechanical facilities); and
 - (d) the Administration's response on whether the new-term Government would develop a concrete policy on bazaars.
