

Subcommittee on Issues Relating to Bazaars

Follow-up actions arising from the meeting on 24 October 2017

1. The Administration is requested to provide before the next Subcommittee meeting scheduled for 7 November 2017, information on :
 - (a) a copy of the new guidelines developed by the Administration to facilitate the public in making applications for setting up bazaars; and
 - (b) details and implementation timetable regarding the initiative to "select suitable non-profit-making organization to operate a weekend flea market on the Tourism Node site at the former airport runway tip" as announced in the Policy Agenda 2017 to be taken forward by the Development Bureau.
2. The Administration is requested to provide information on :
 - (c) a list of open spaces at the rooftop of public markets that are
 - (i) managed by the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department;
 - (ii) used by other departments for designated purposes (e.g. leisure venues managed by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department)
 - and (iii) used for installing facilities (e.g. electrical and mechanical facilities); and
 - (d) the Administration's response on whether the new-term Government would develop a concrete policy on bazaars.
